

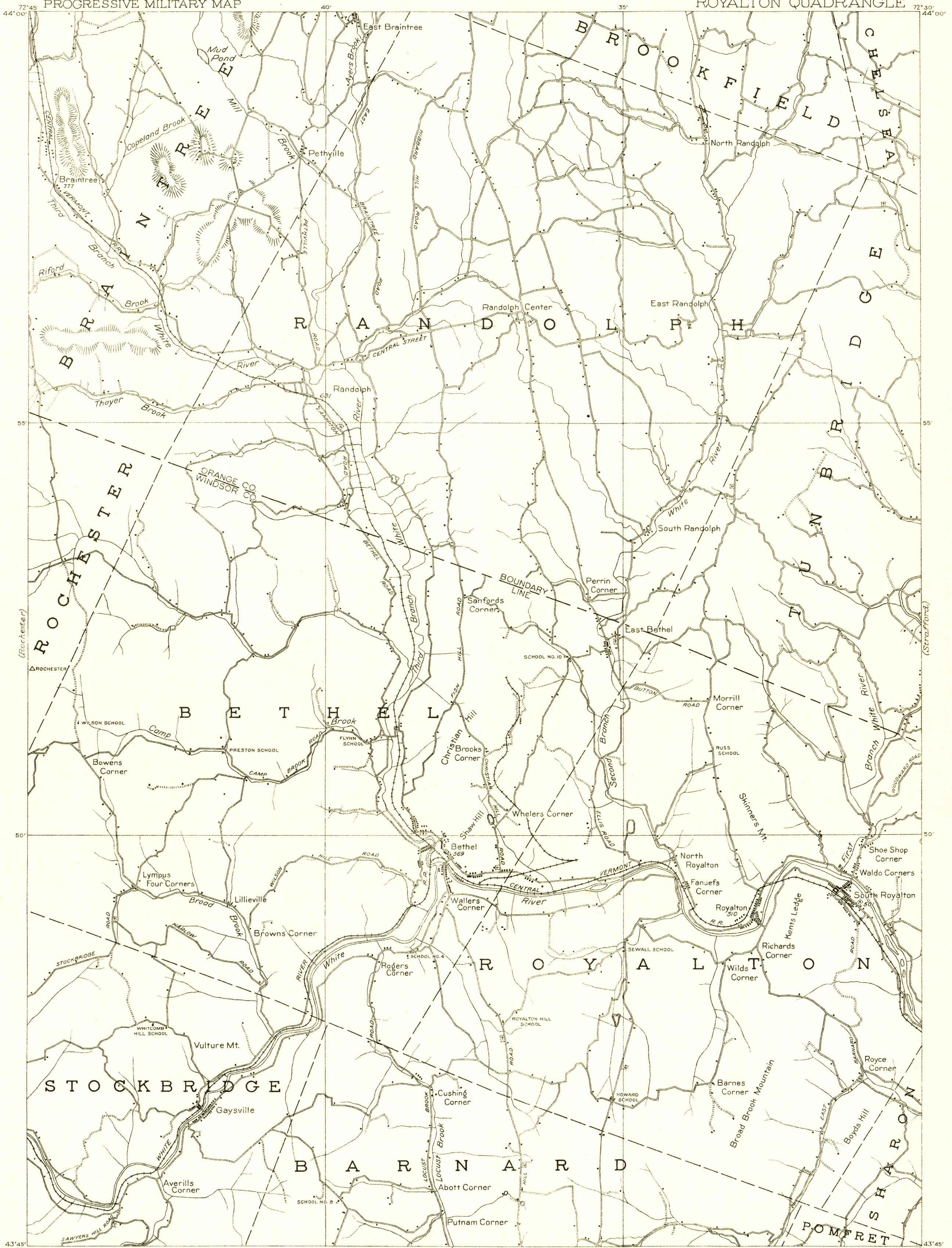

PROGRESSIVE MILITARY MAP

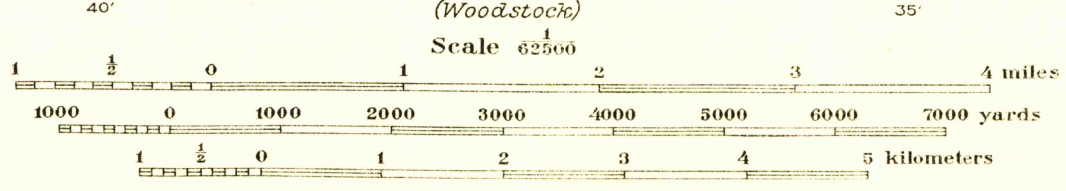

ROYALTON QUADRANGLE

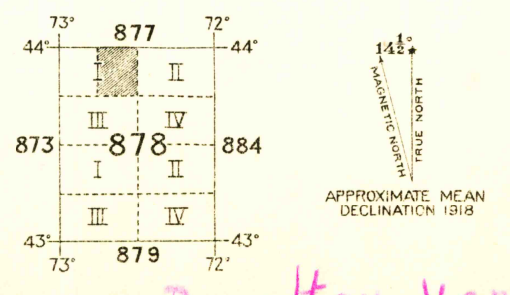
