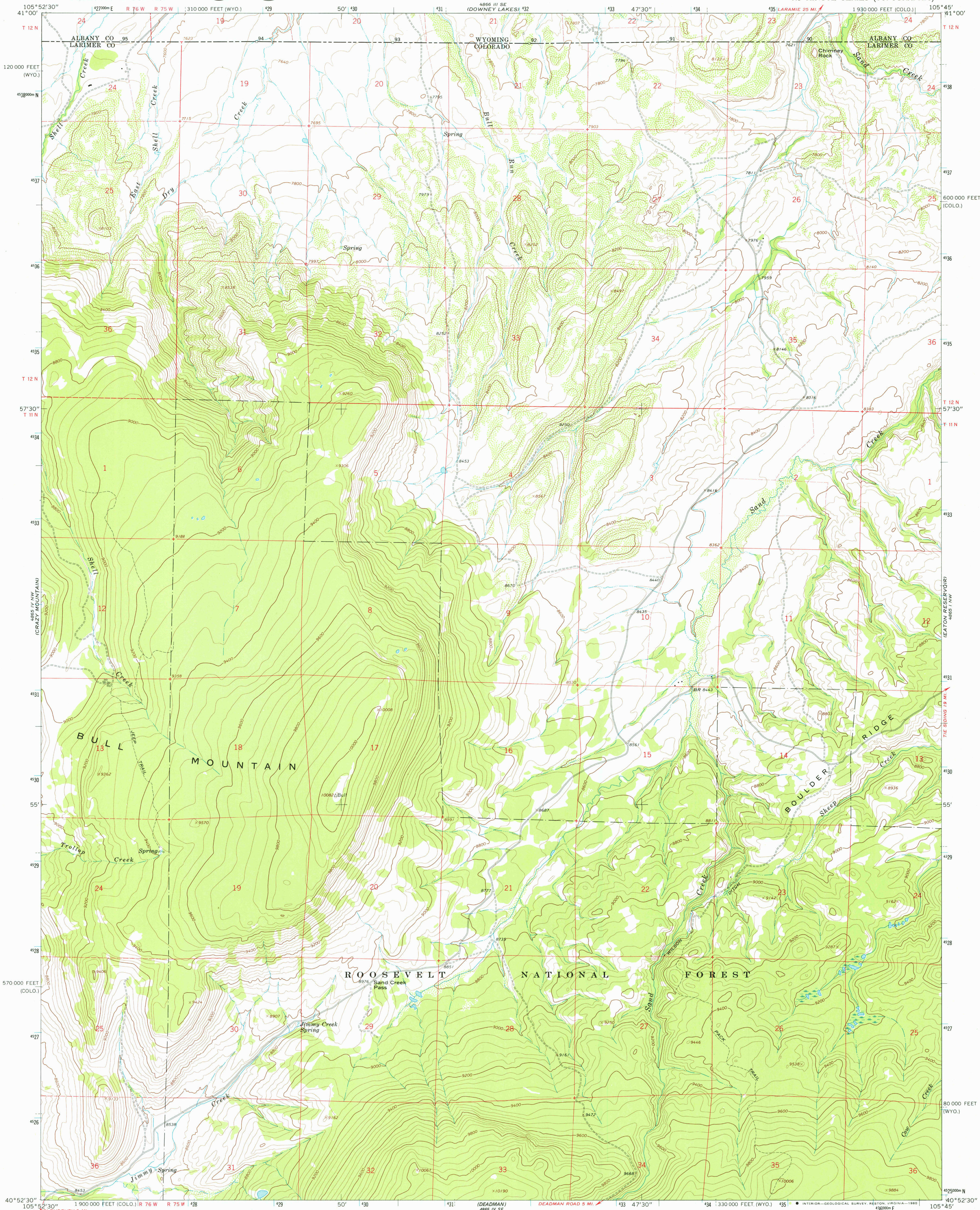
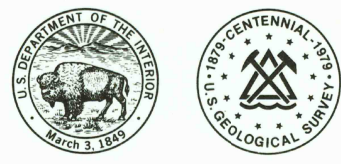

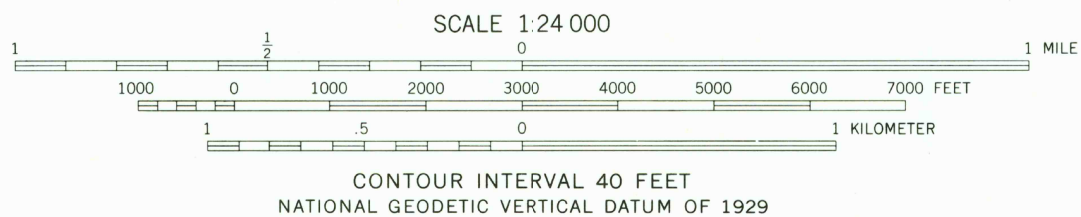
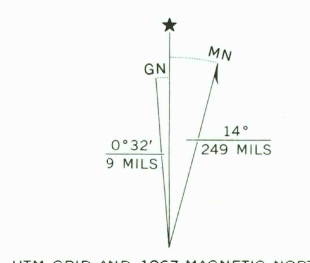
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1966. Field checked 1967
