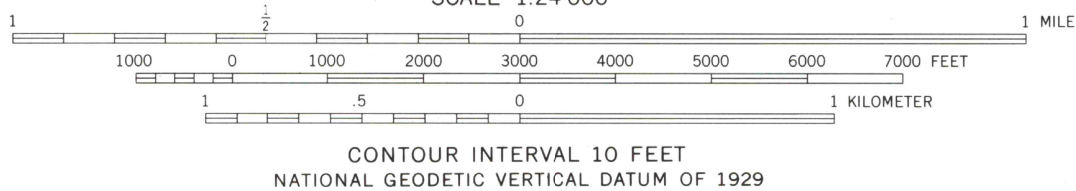
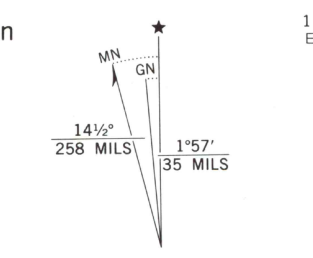

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

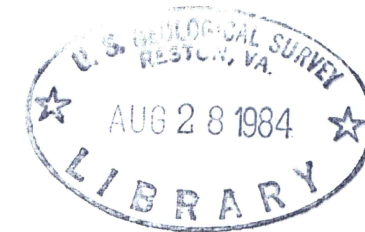


CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 FEET
