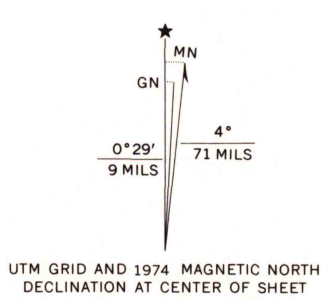

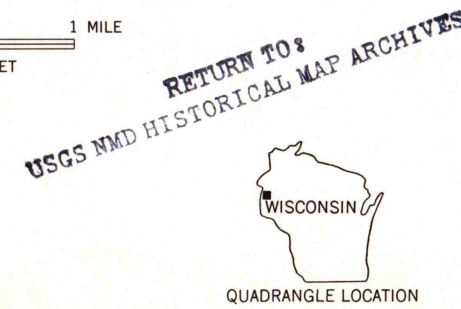
BALSAM LAKE SE QUADRANGLE
