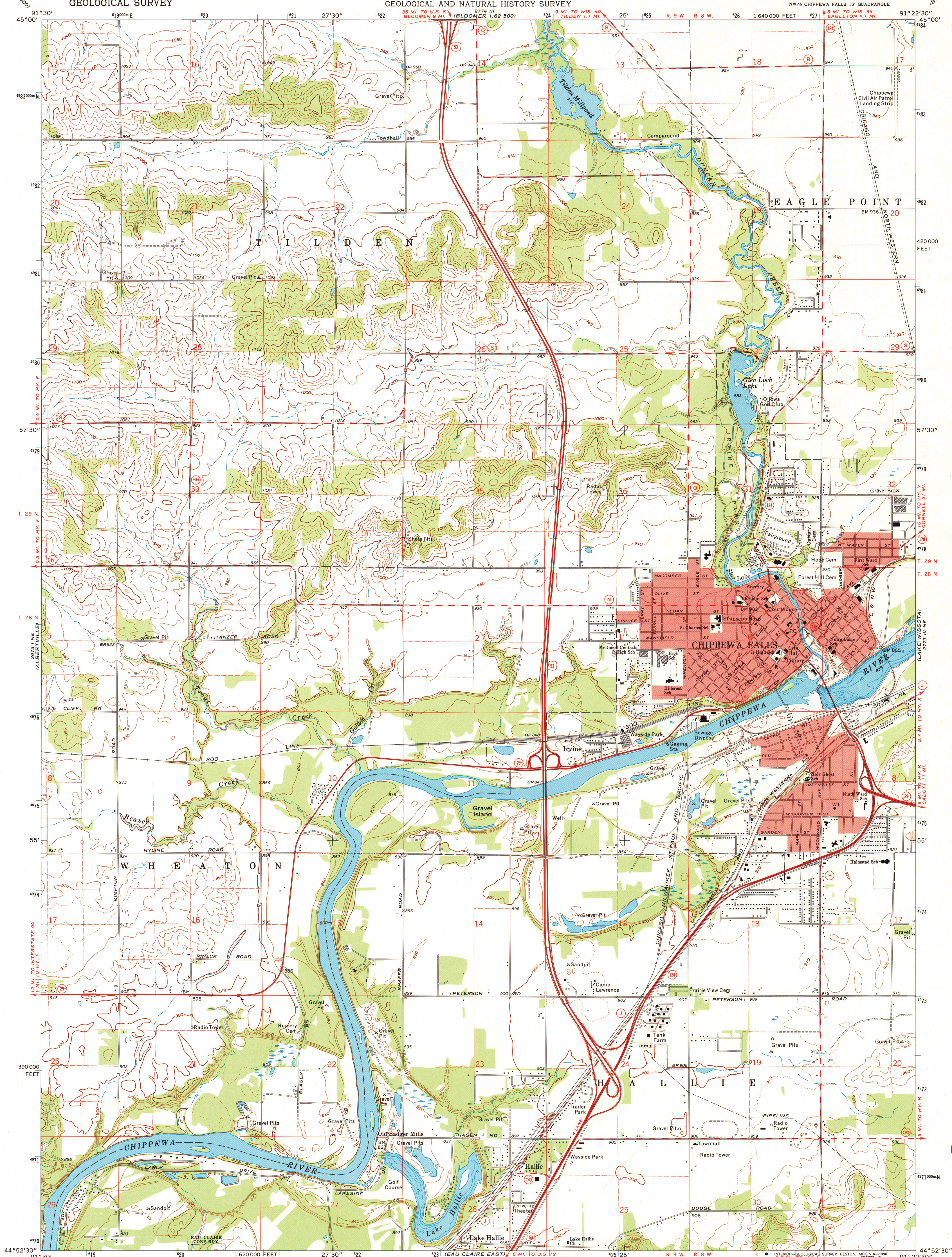

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Wisconsin coordinate system, central zone (Lambert conformal conic). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum. Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs.
