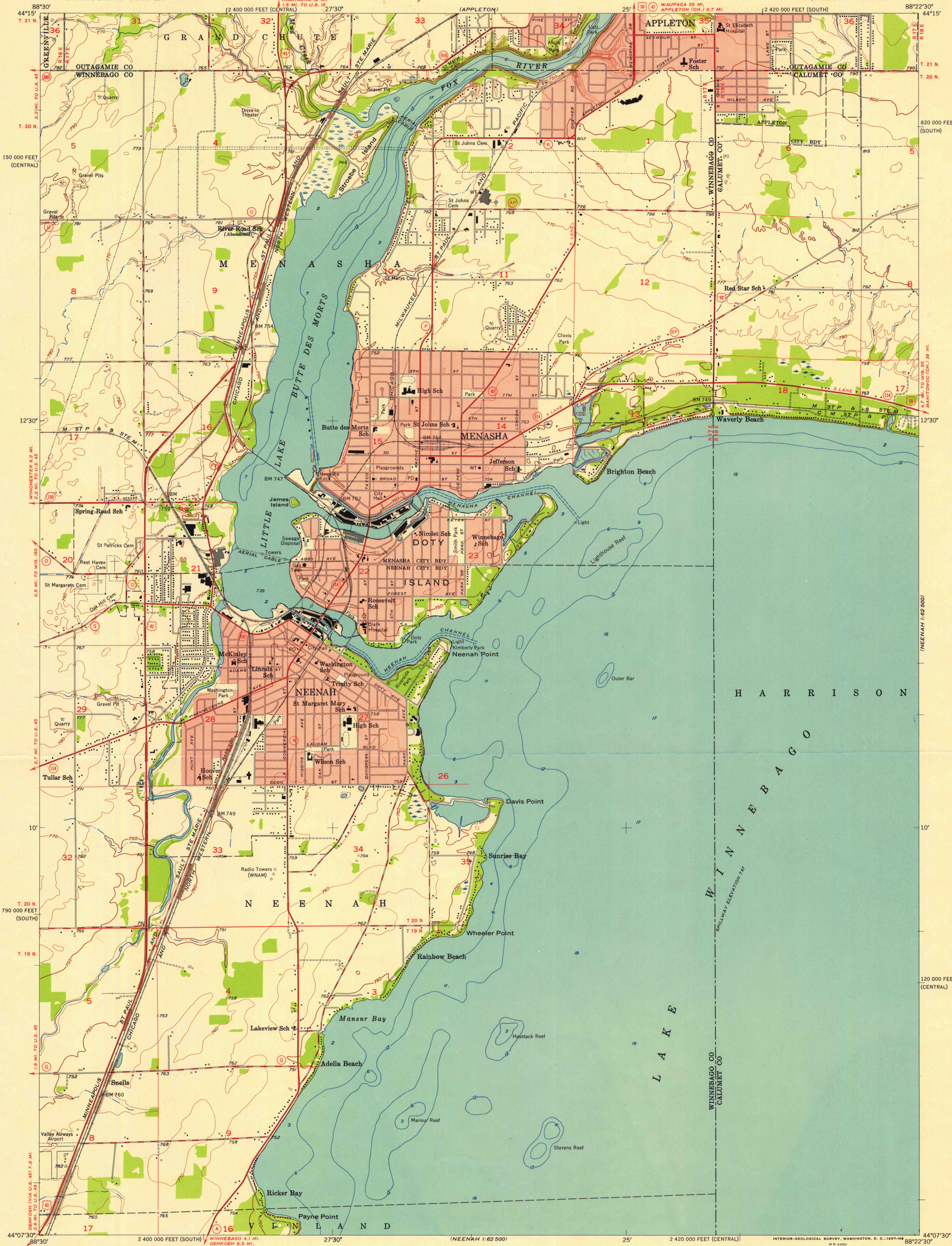

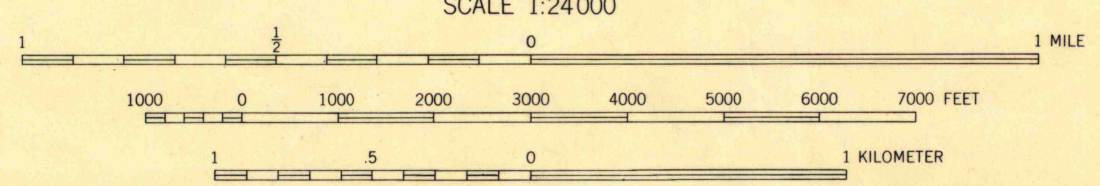
NEENAH QUADRANGLE
