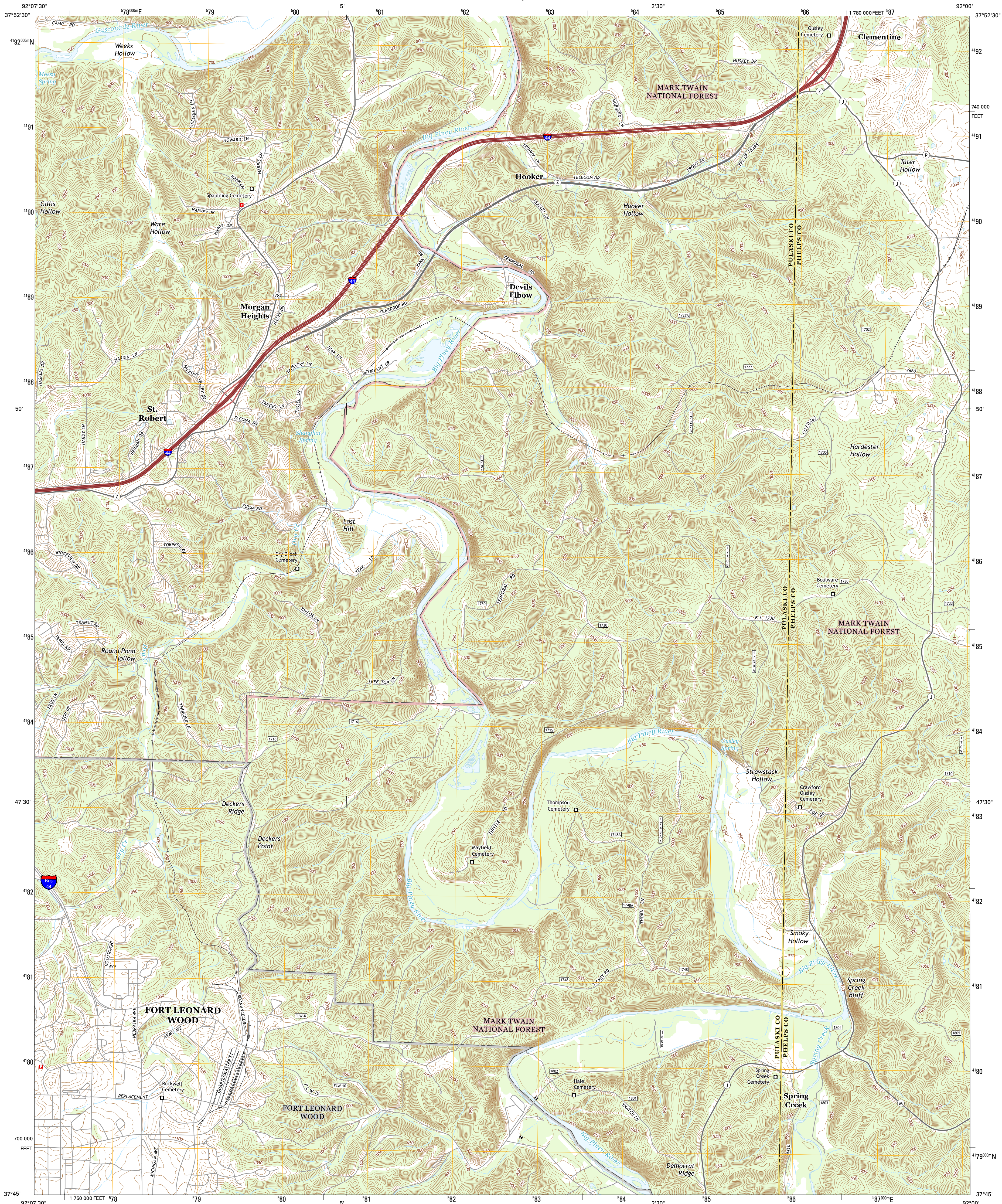

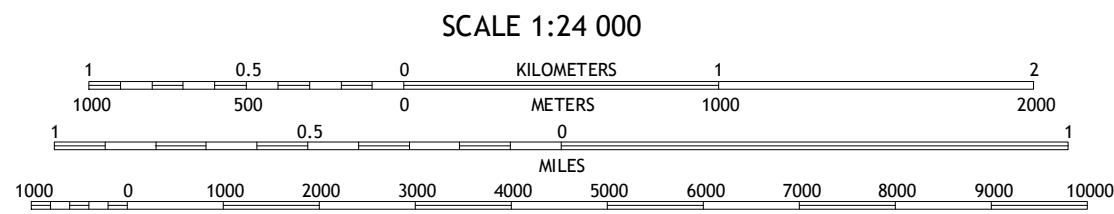
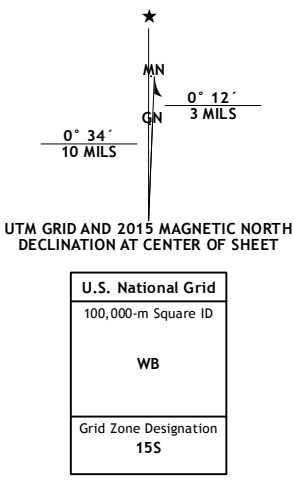
DEVILS ELBOW QUADRANGLE
