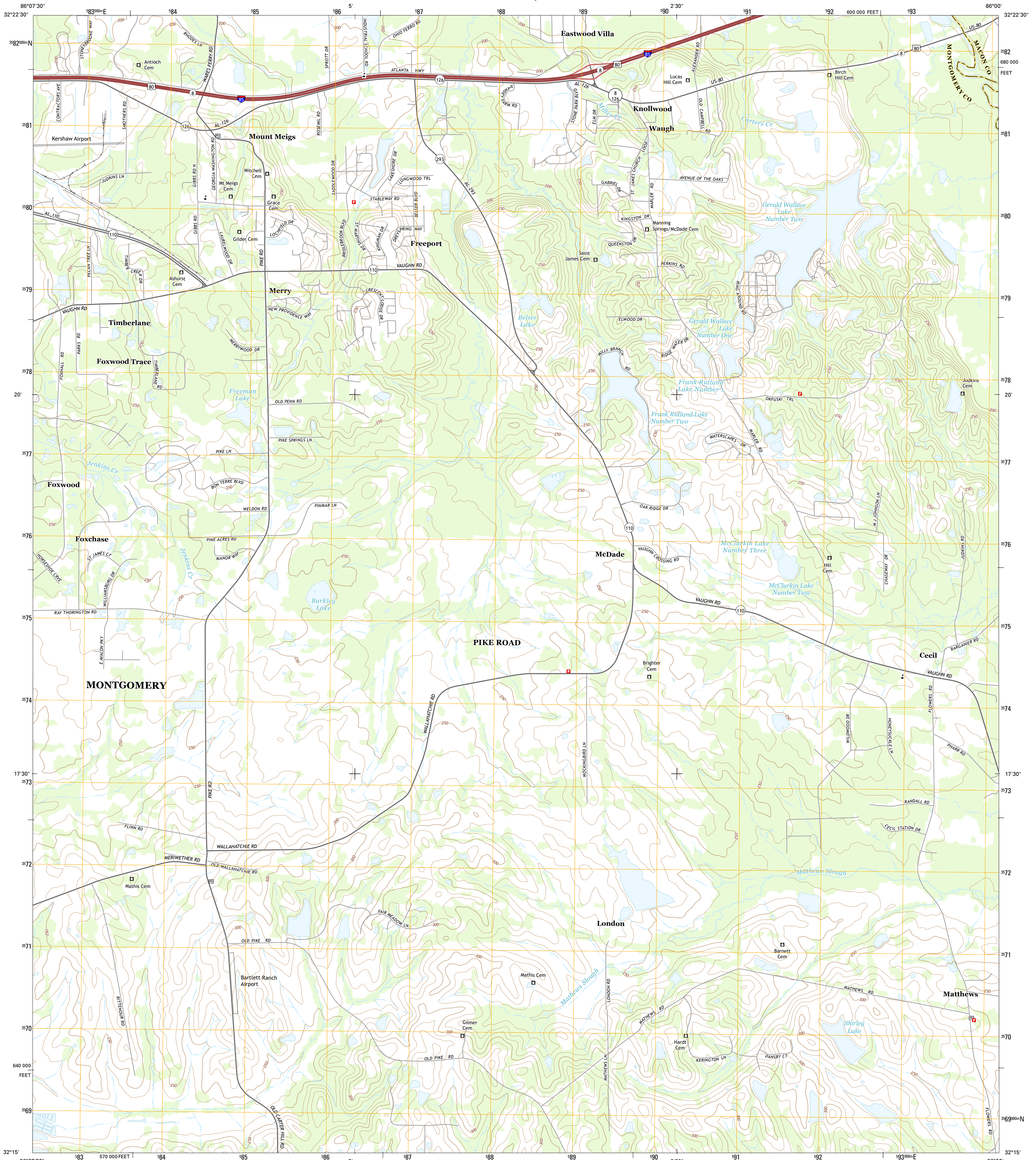

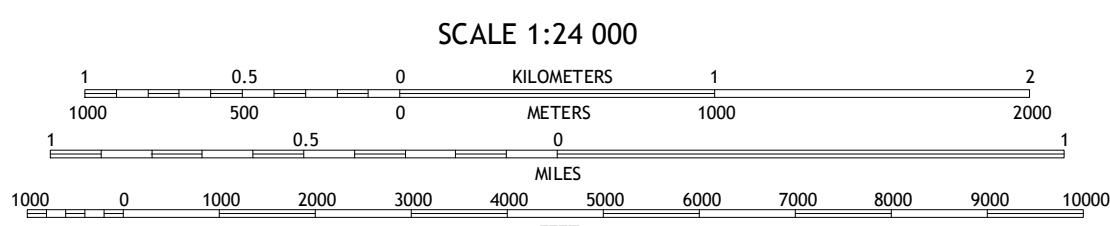


MOUNT MEIGS QUADRANGLE
