The graphic scale bar is divided into four units: Miles, Feet, Kilometers, and Meters. The Miles scale ranges from 0 to 1 with a major tick at 0.5. The Feet scale ranges from 0 to 10,000 with major ticks every 1,000 feet. The Kilometers scale ranges from 0 to 2 with a major tick at 1. The Meters scale ranges from 0 to 2,000 with major ticks every 500 meters. The bar is color-coded with alternating light and dark segments.
