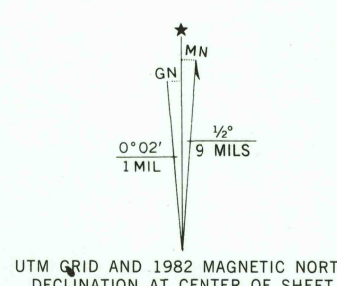

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Indiana coordinate system, west zone and Kentucky coordinate system, south zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 1 meter east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked. The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1912, and supplementary information.
