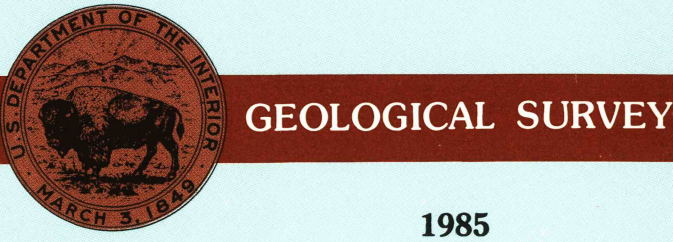

DECLINATION DIAGRAM

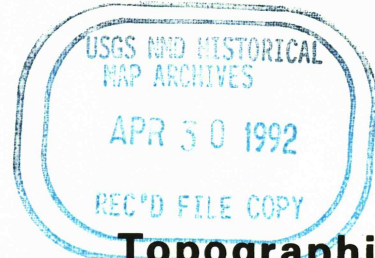
UTM grid convergence (CON) and 1983 magnetic declination (MAG) at center of map
