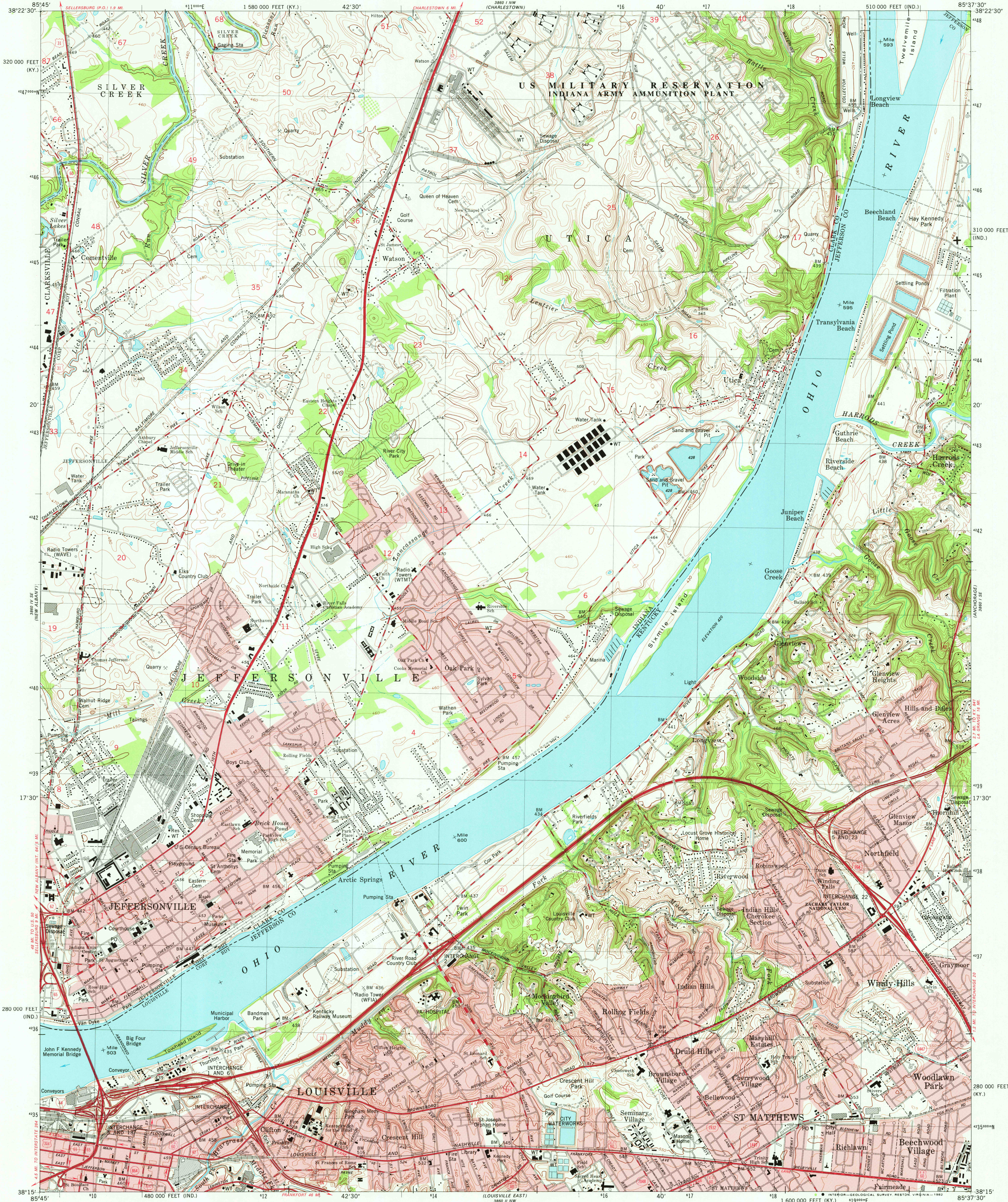
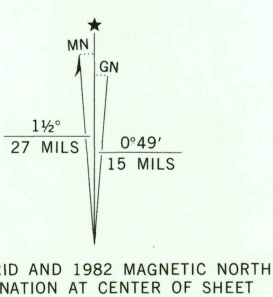

Topography in Indiana by planetable surveys 1937. Topography in Kentucky by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1949. Field checked 1950. Revised from aerial photographs taken 1978. Field checked 1979. Map edited 1982.
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Indiana coordinate system, east zone, and Kentucky coordinate system, north zone.
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16, 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 3 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
Indiana area lies within Clark Military Grant. Dotted land lines established by private survey.
The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low waterline as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1912-1913 and supplementary information.
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
