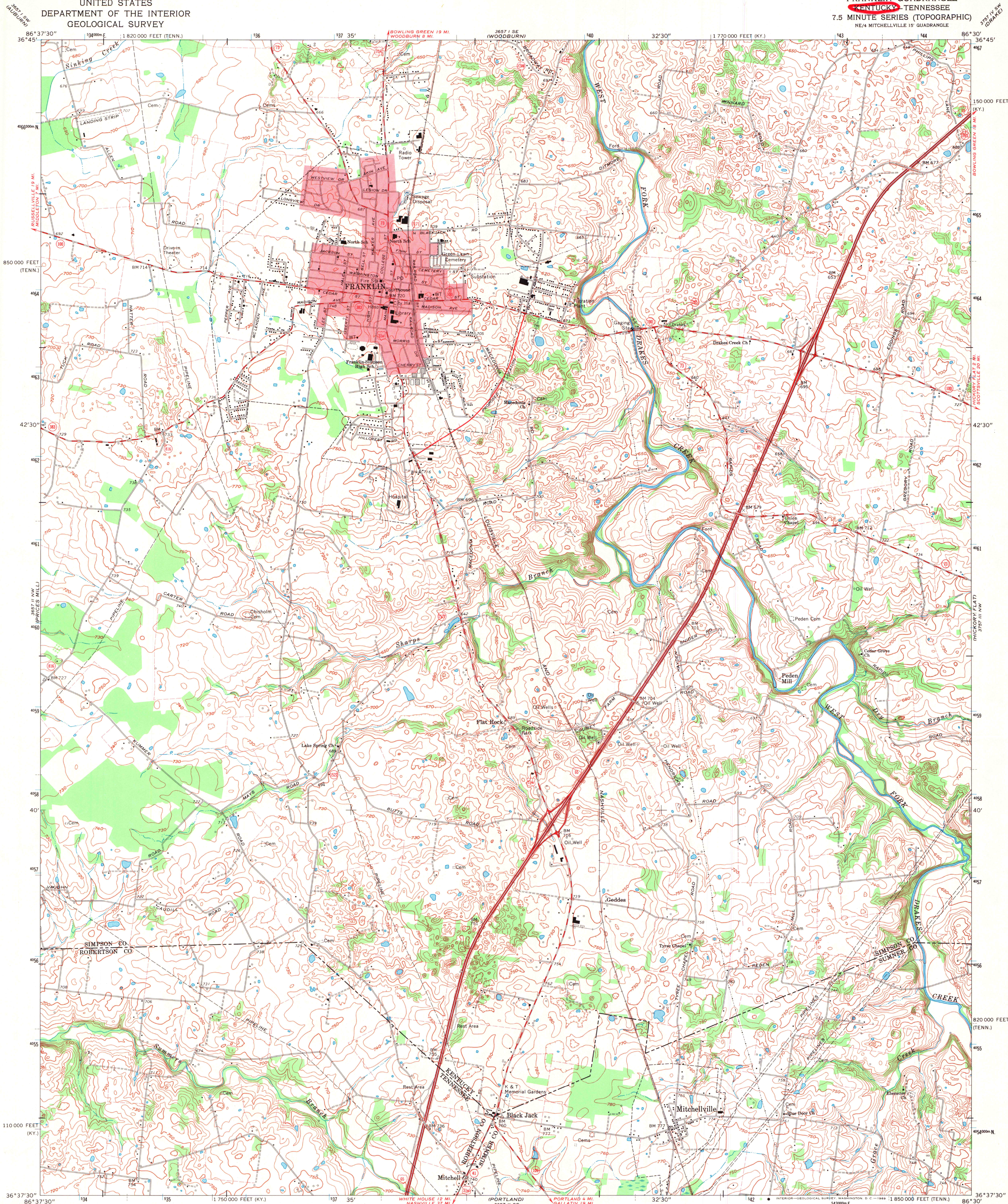

NE/4 MITCHELLVILLE 15' QUADRANGLE

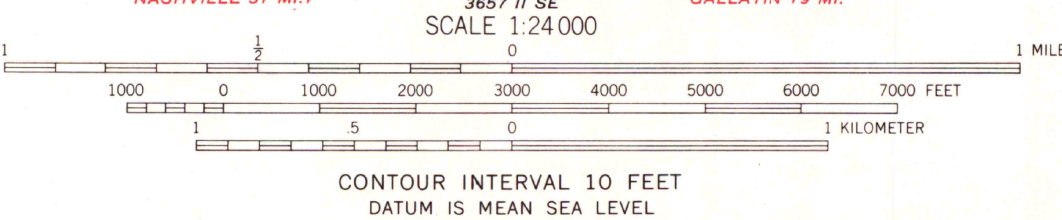

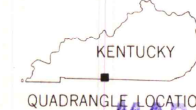
