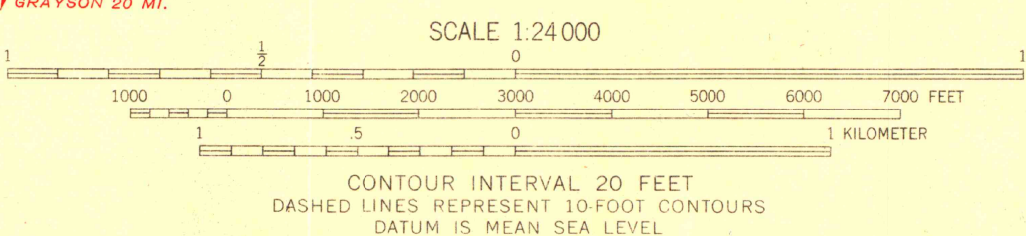
GREENUP QUADRANGLE

SURVEYED IN 1910, 1915, AND 1926, SCALE 1:62,500

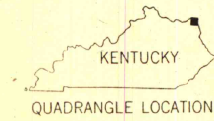
