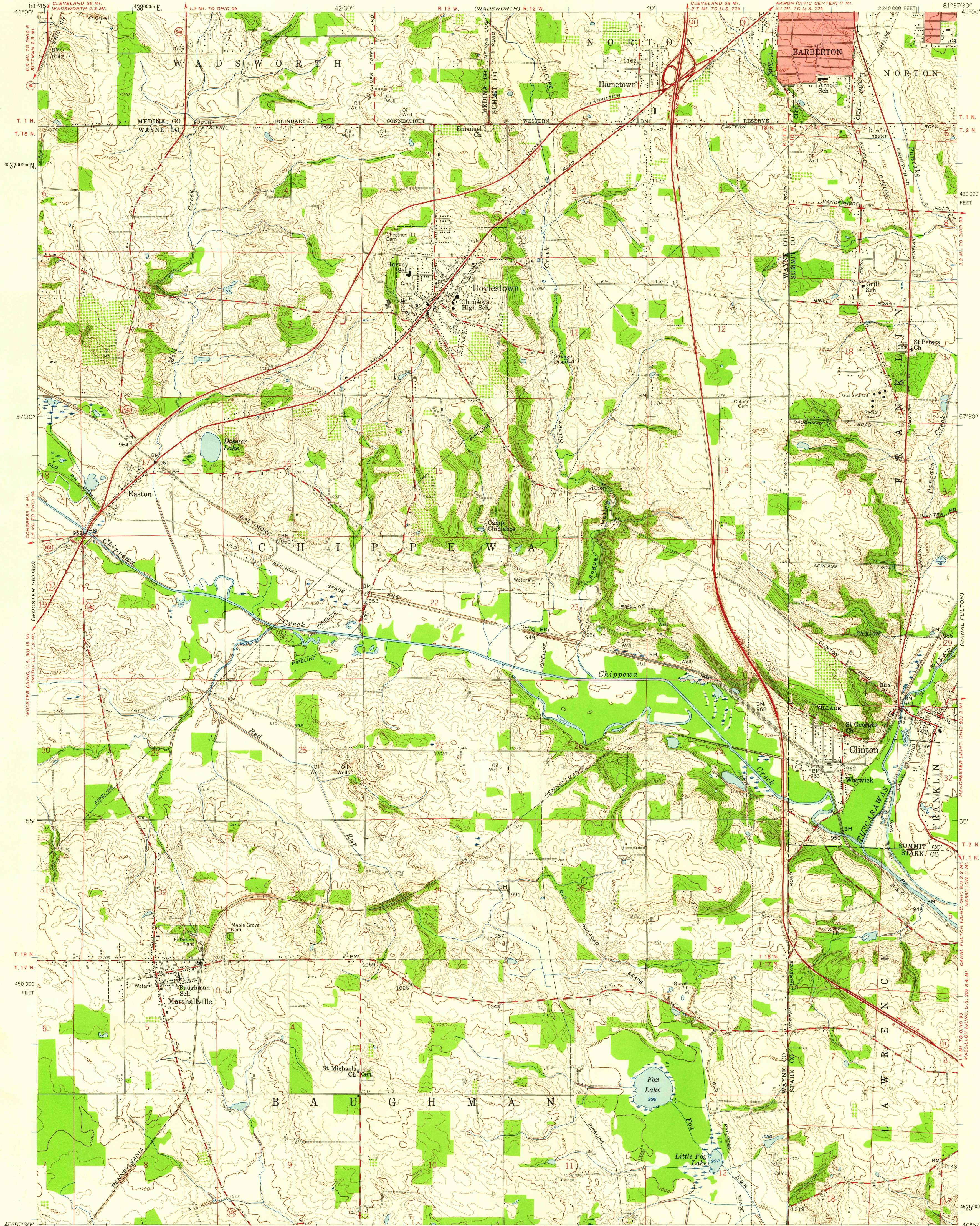

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

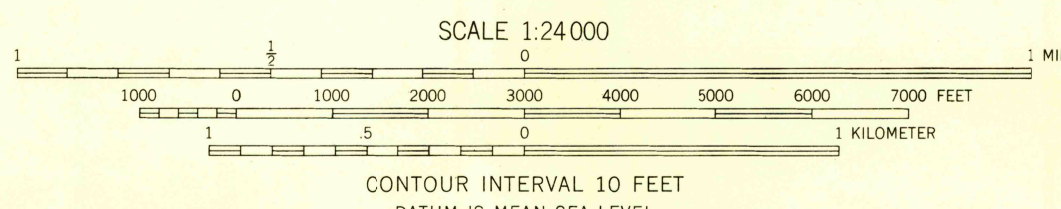
Unlabelled wells are gas wells
