1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue.

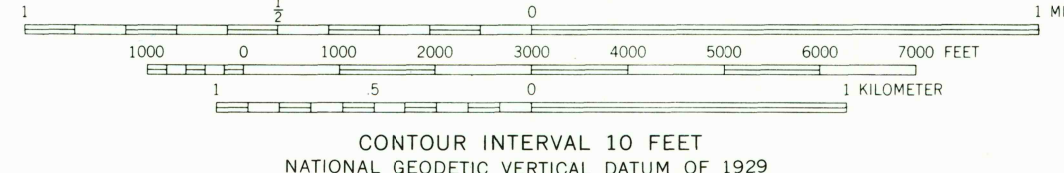
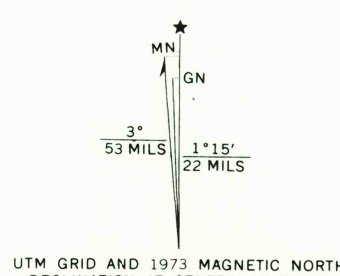
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
