

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Ohio coordinate system, south zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue. The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5-minute sections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on photographs. This information is unchecked. Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown. Entire area lies within the Between the Miamis.
