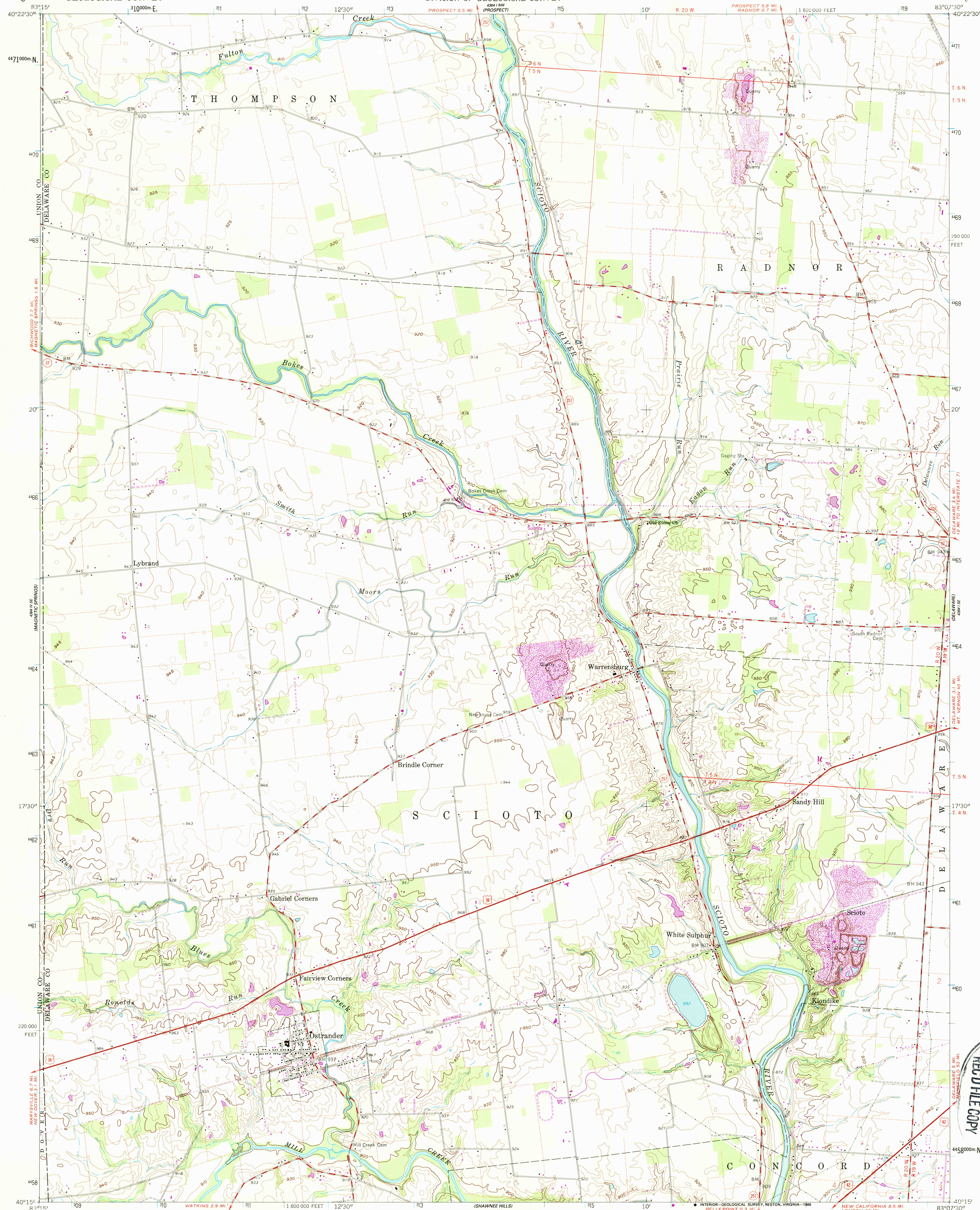

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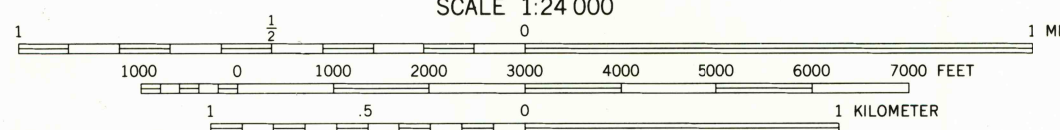
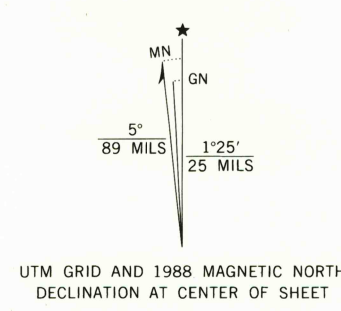
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 2 meters south and
9 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Virginia Military District
Area east of the Scioto River lies within the
United States Military District
Land lines based on the Base Line of the
United States Military District
