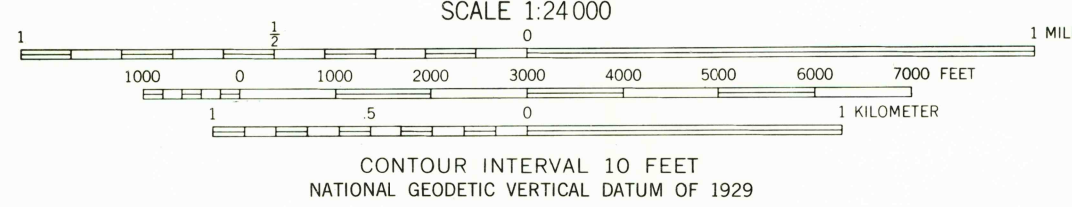

14 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is uncheckd
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
Entire area lies within the Connecticut Western Reserve
Dotted land lines established by private subdivision of
the Connecticut Western Reserve
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map
