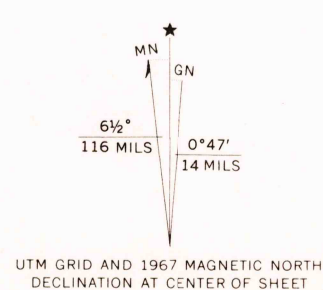

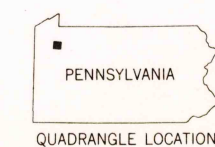
DEMPSEYTOWN QUADRANGLE
