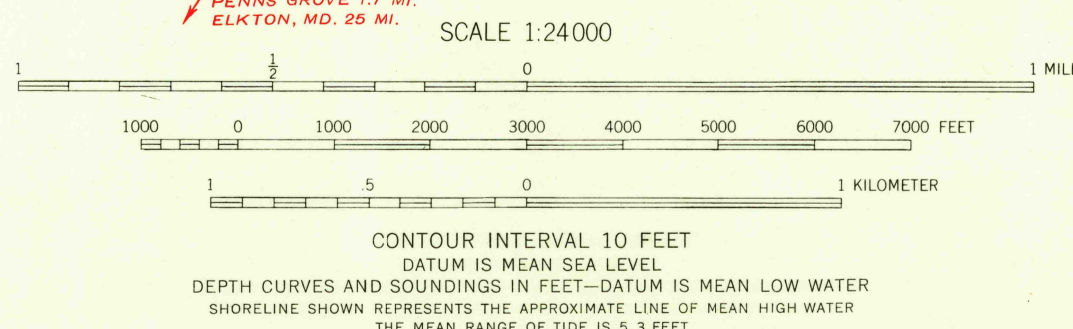

SW1/4 CHESTER 15' QUADRANGLE



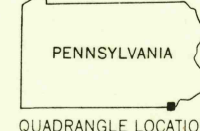
