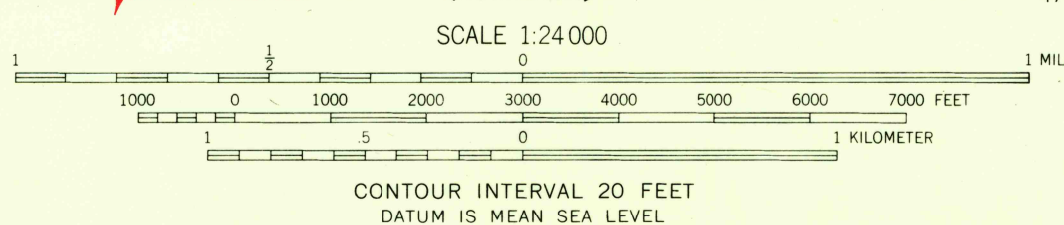

NE 1/4 MT. UNION 15' QUADRANGLE

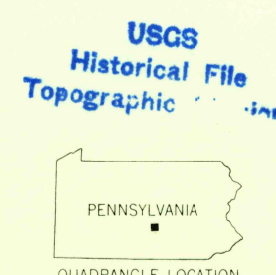
