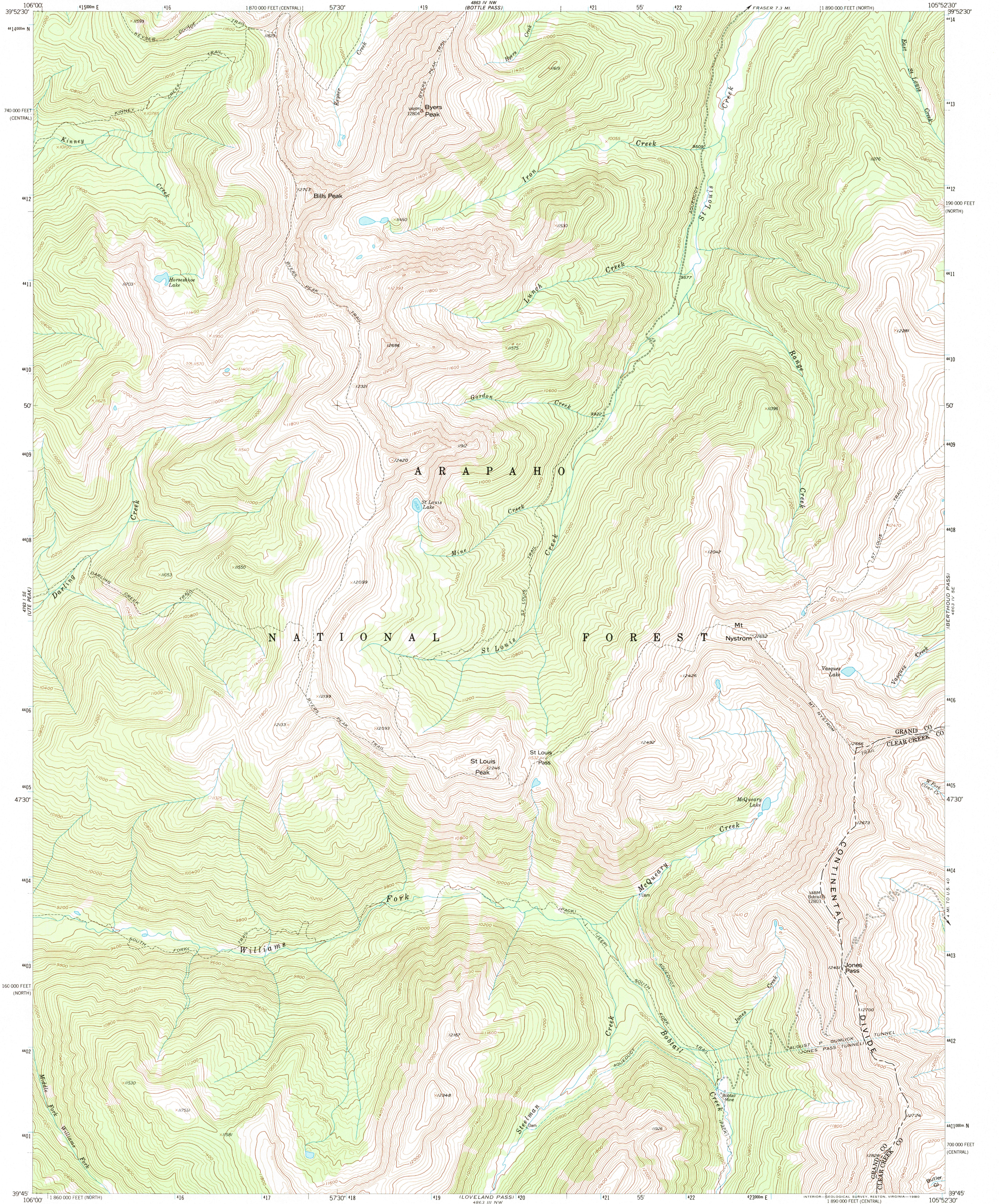

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1953. Field checked 1957.

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, north and central zones.

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.

Land lines have not been established in this area.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 50 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
