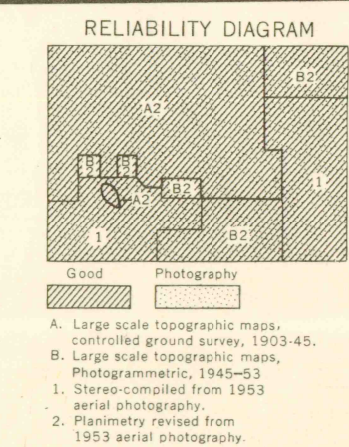
TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION
