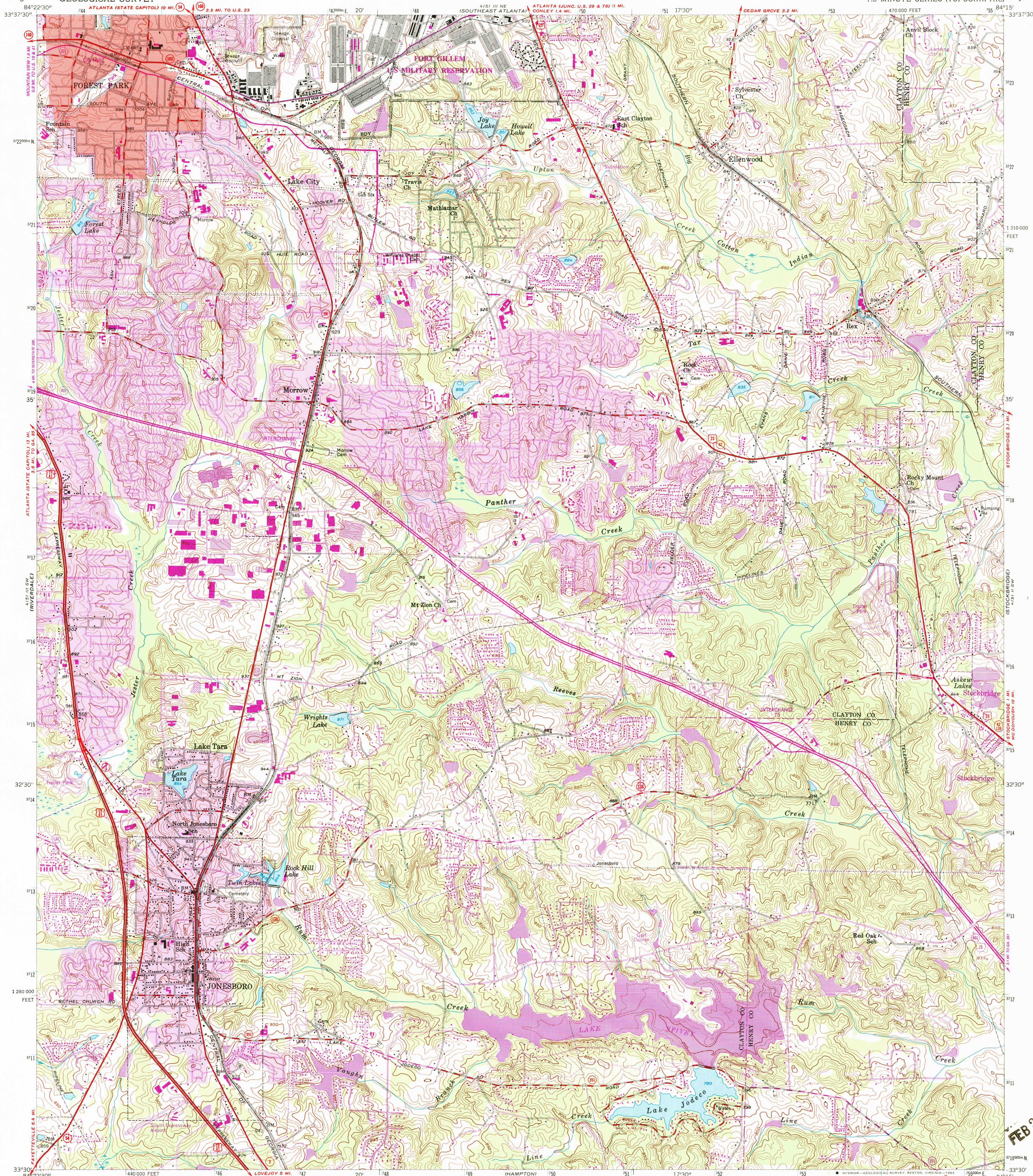

1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 11 meters south and 8 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.

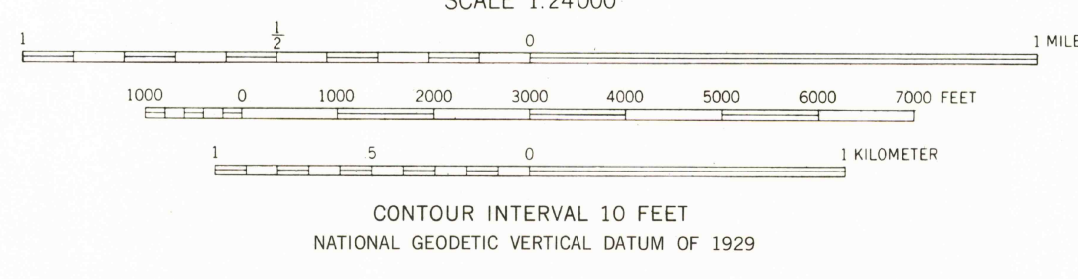
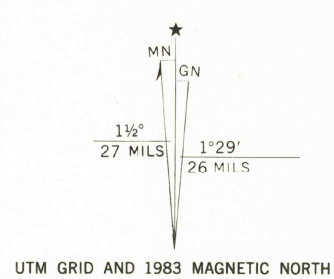
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
