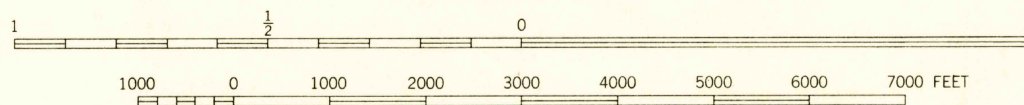

and Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone

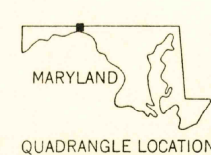
