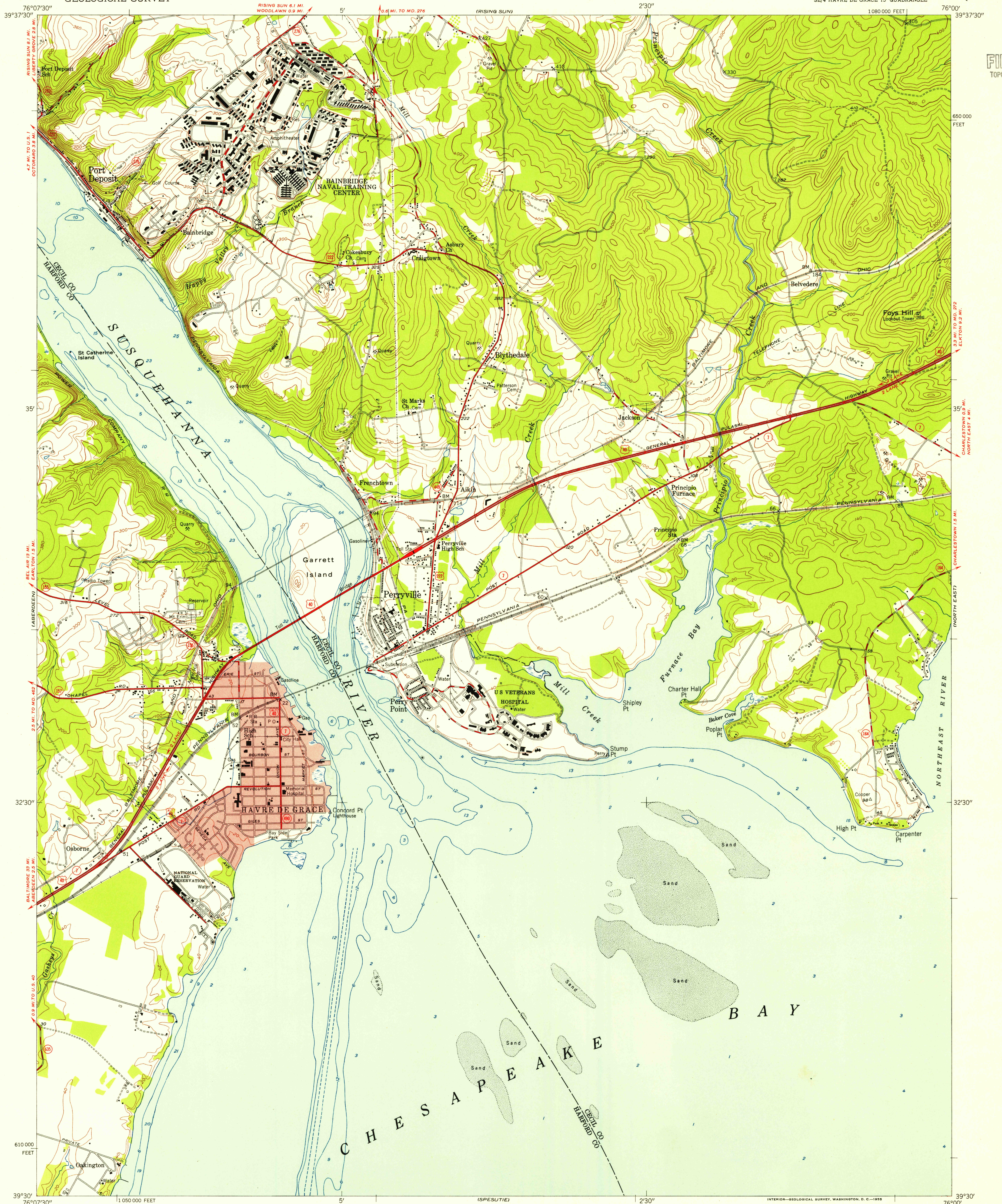

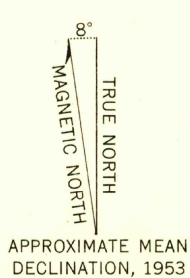

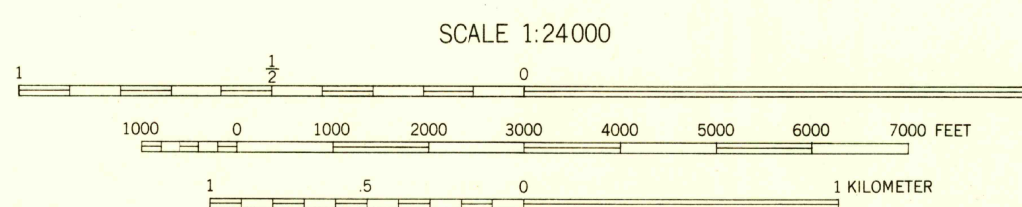

APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION, 1953

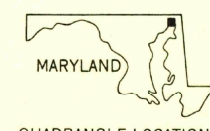
