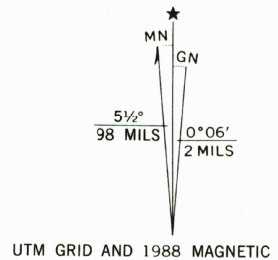

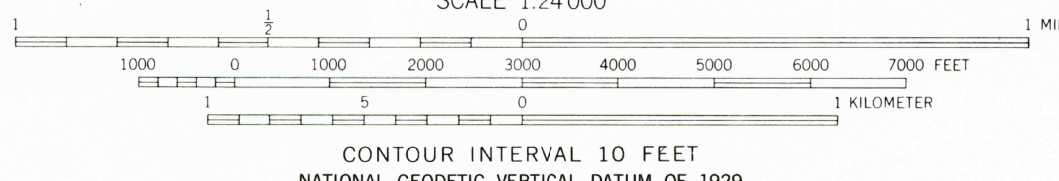
WEDDINGTON QUADRANGLE
