

coordinate system, central zone (transverse Mercator)  
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13  
1927 North American datum  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 4 meters north and  
51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the  
National or State reservations shown on this map
