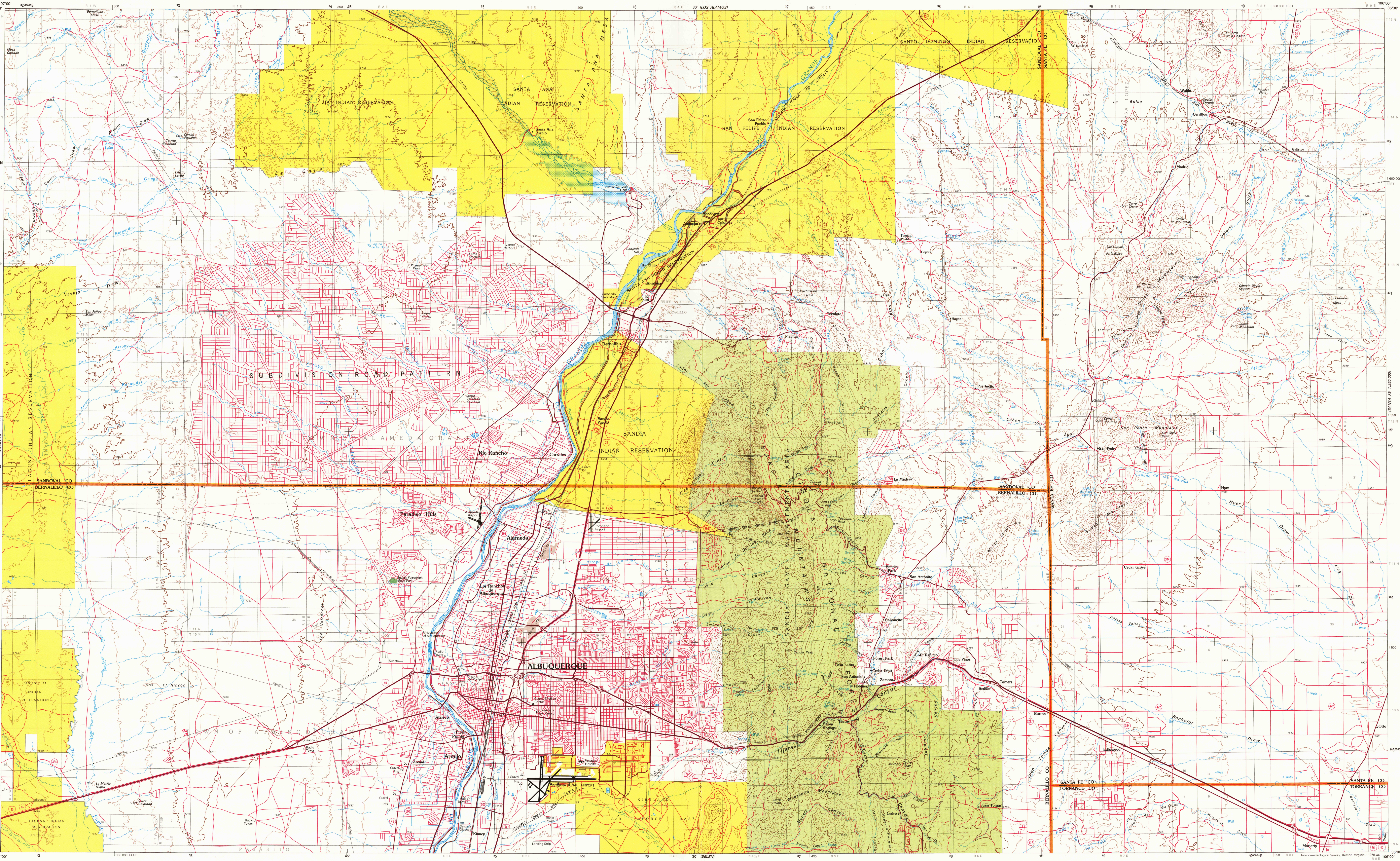


COYOTE MESA

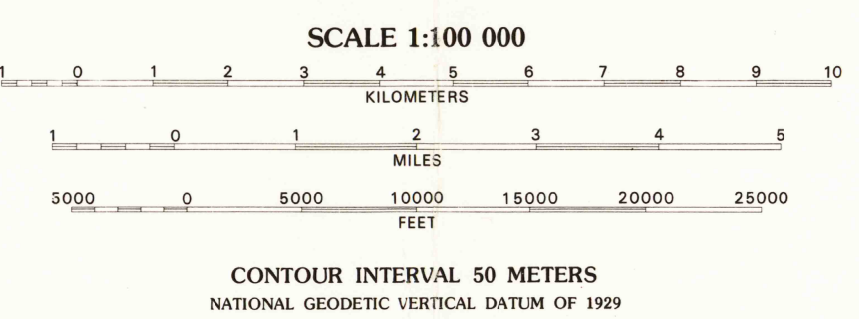
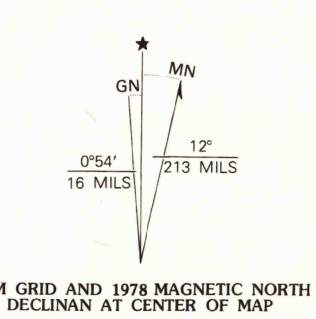
