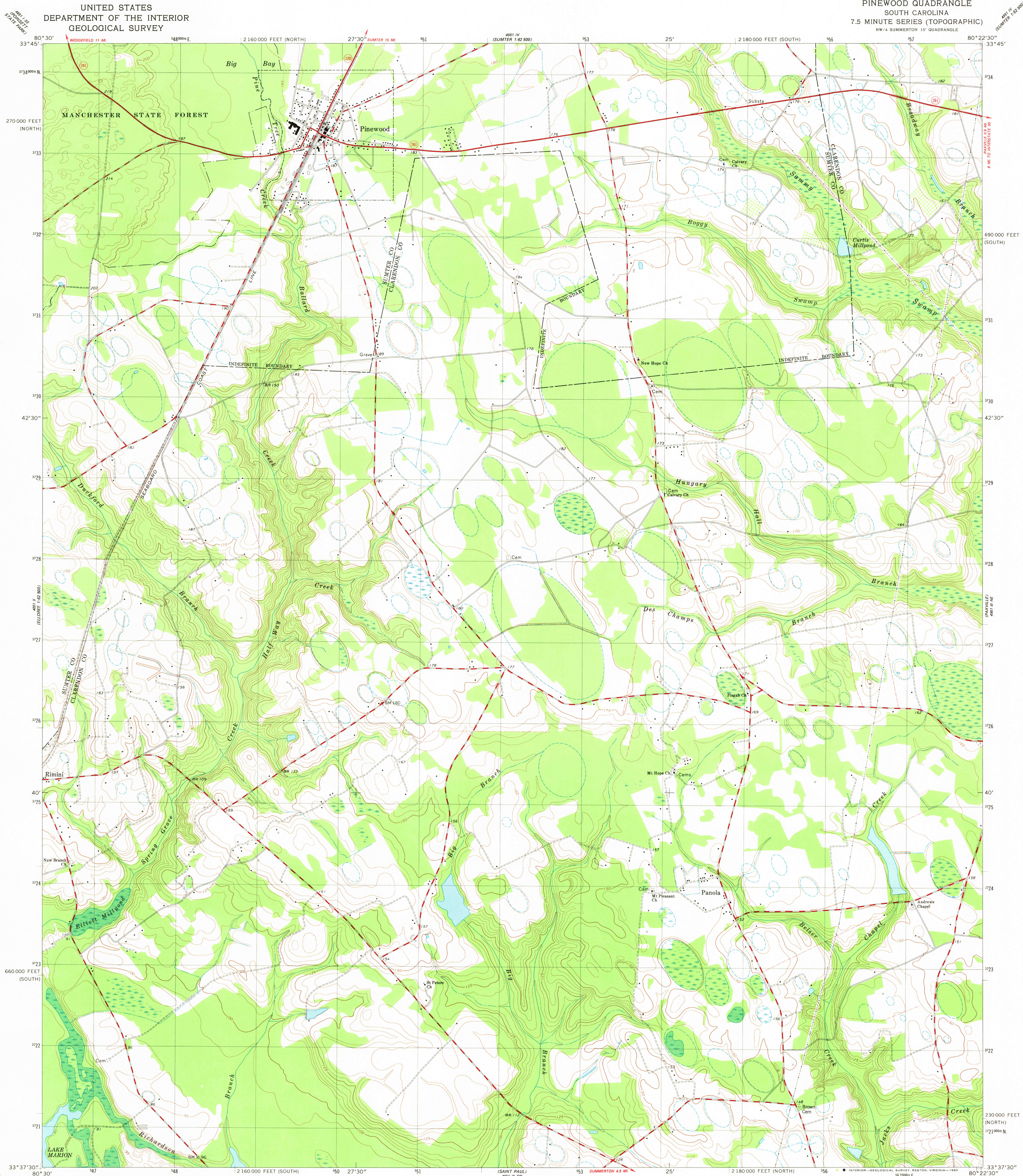

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 18 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Short dashed blue lines indicate elliptical bay outlines visible on aerial photographs
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
