

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Montana coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic) 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks zone 12, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Where omitted, land lines have not been established
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters north and 70 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
