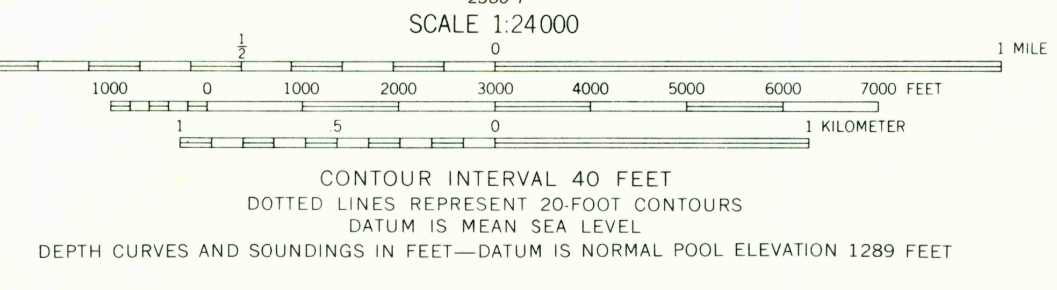
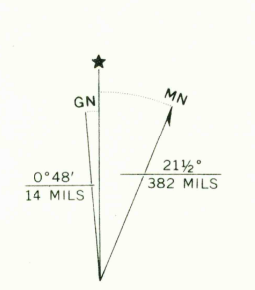

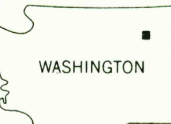
10,000-foot grid based on Washington coordinate system, north zone
