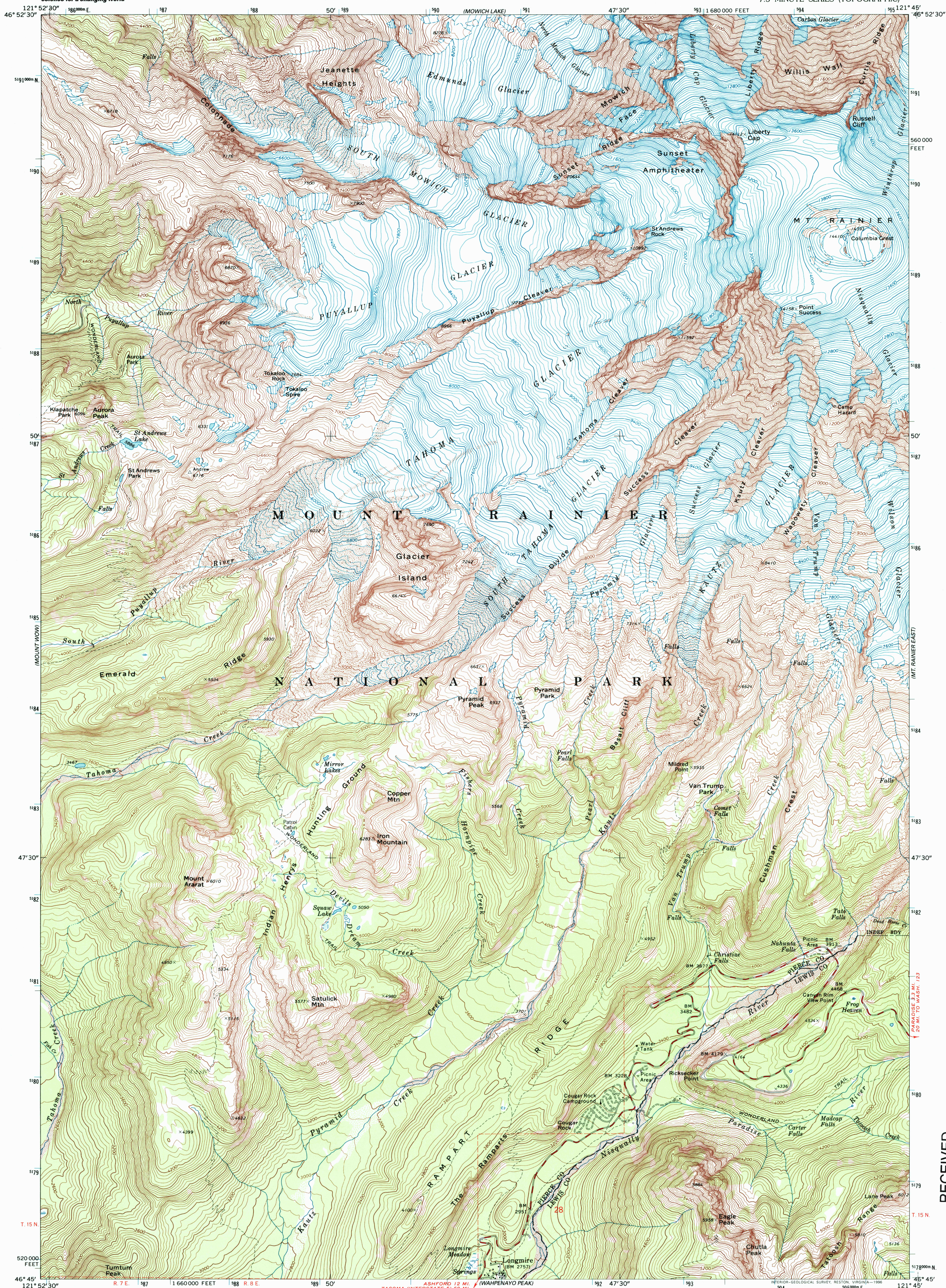

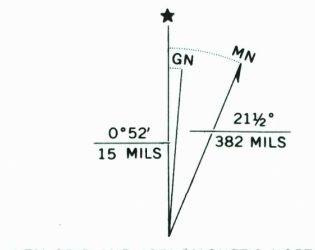

UTM GRID AND 1971 MAGNETIC NORTH

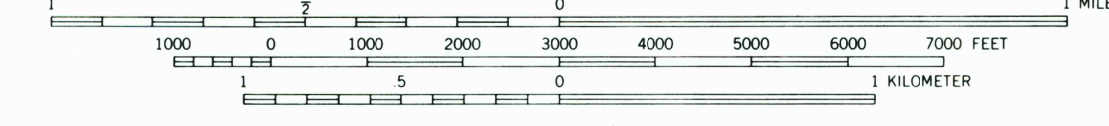
