zone 17, shown in blue

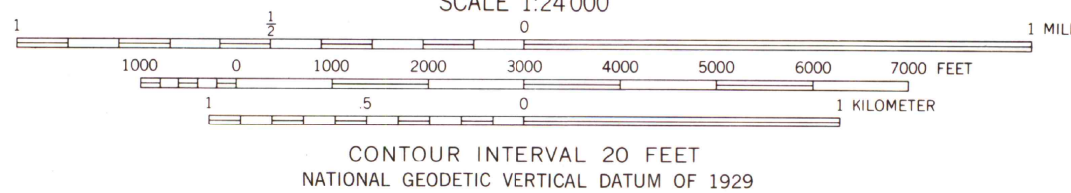
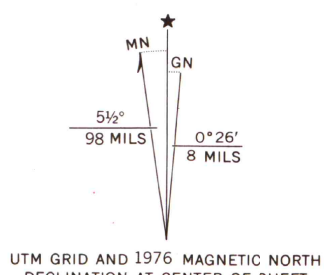
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
