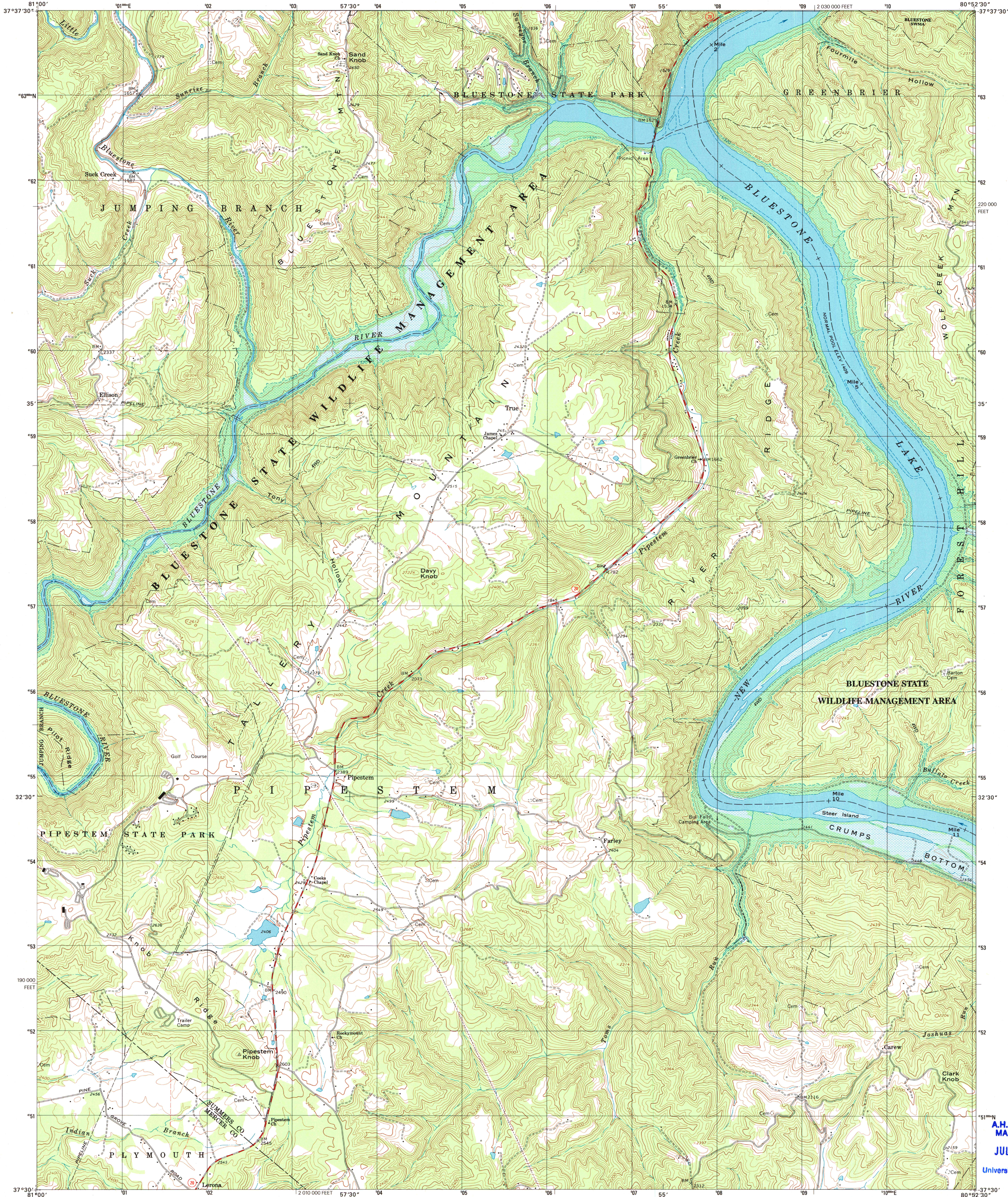




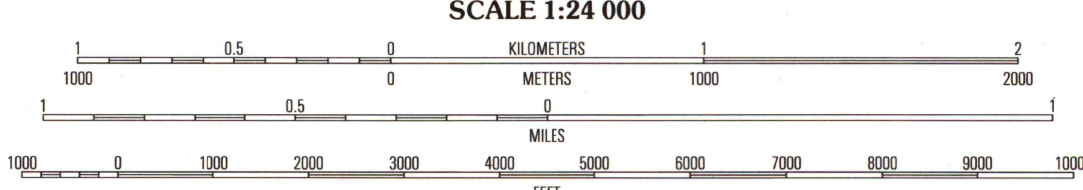
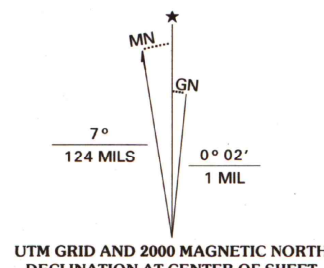

7.5-MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)



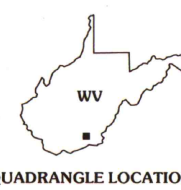
