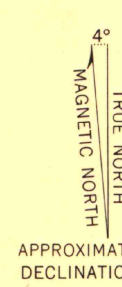

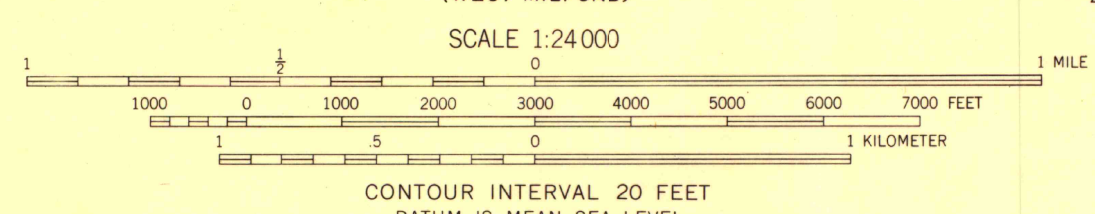

DECLINATION, 1960



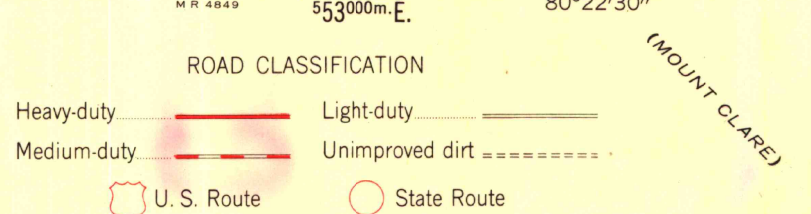
