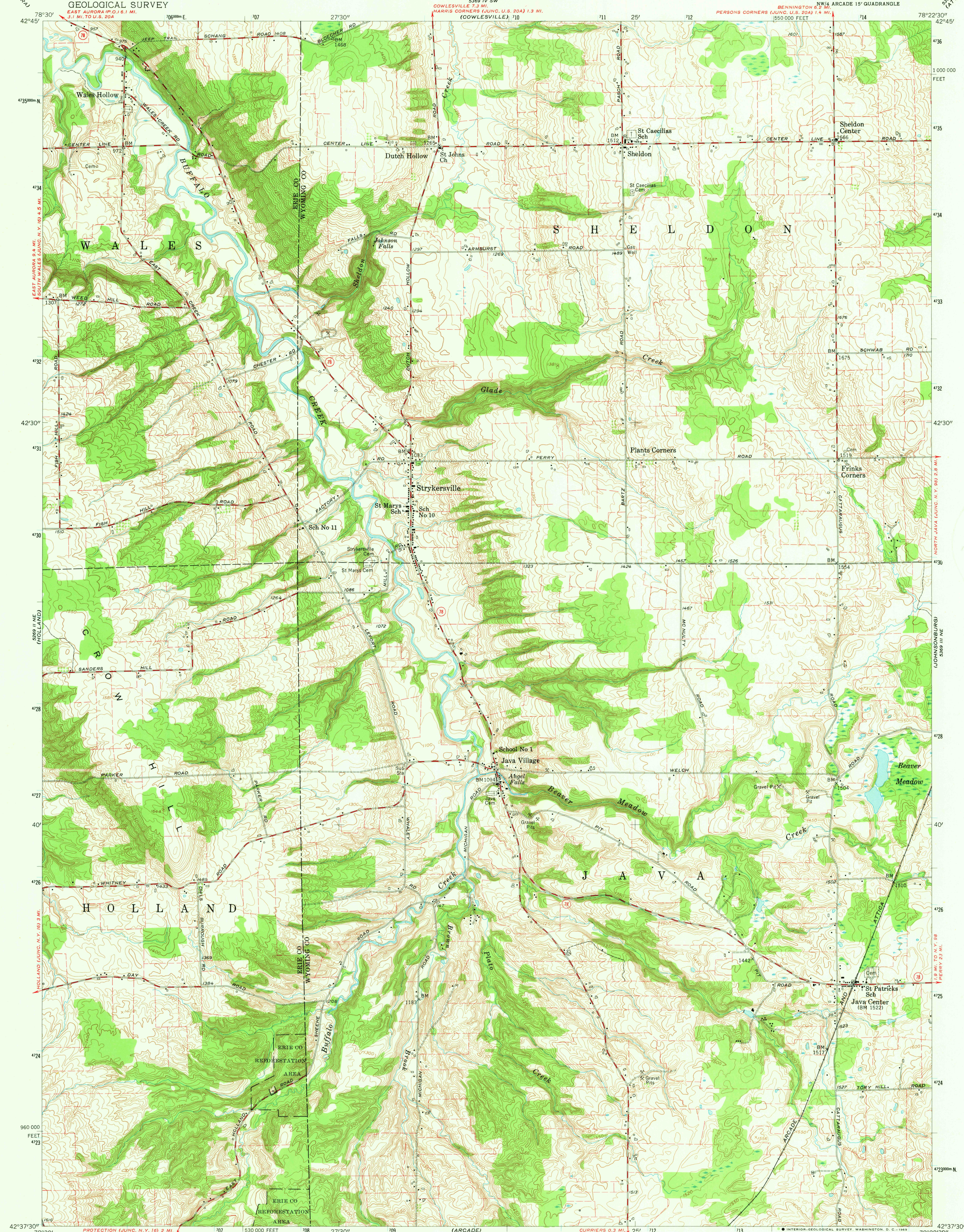

10,000-foot grid based on New York coordinate system, west zone

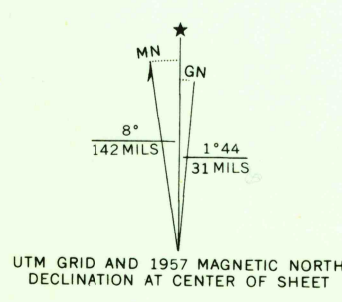
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
