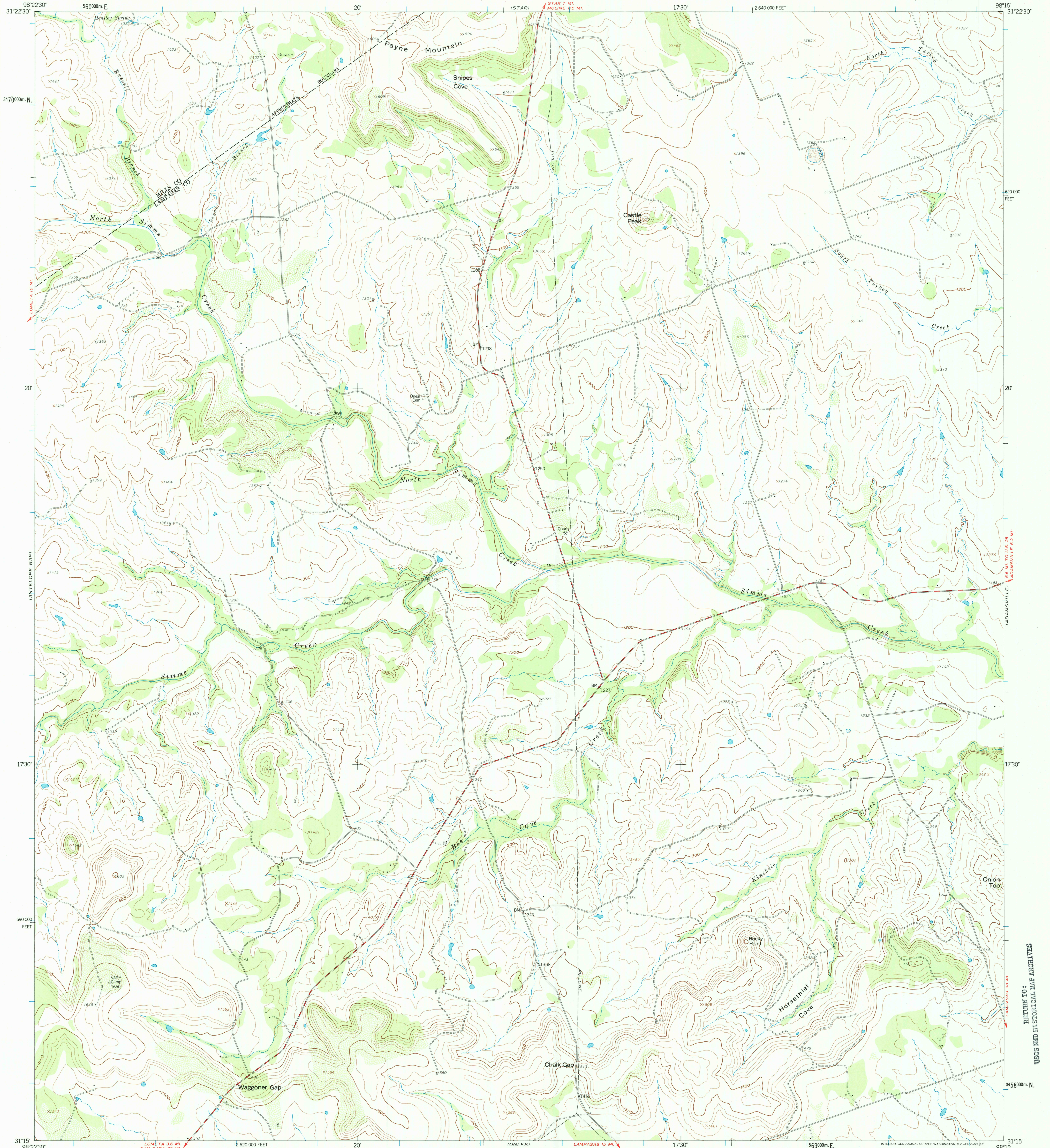
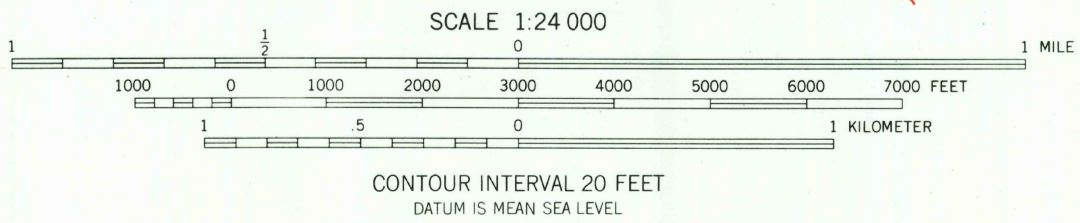

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

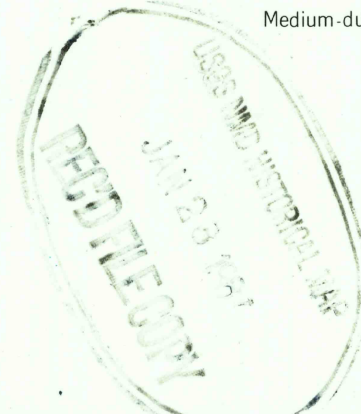
TRUE NORTH
