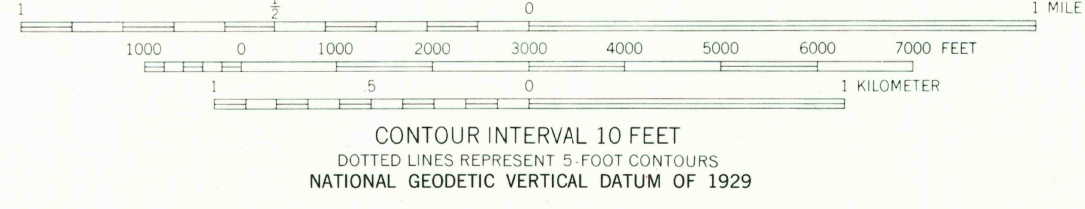
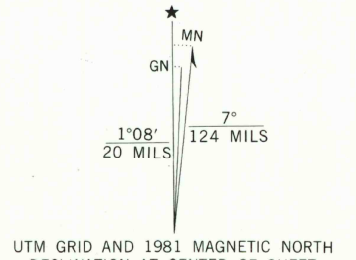

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation to 532 feet
