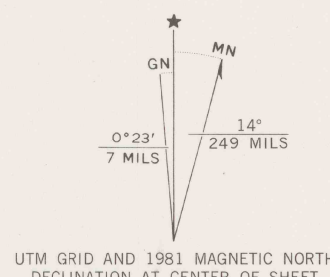

Datum 1983 move the projection lines 83 meters east as shown  
by dashed corner ticks  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown  
Dotted land lines established by private survey  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of  
the National or State reservations shown on this map
