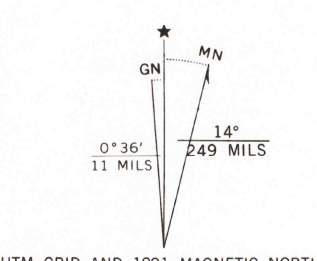

Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue
1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North
American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 1 meter
north and 85 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Dotted land lines established by private surveys
The south half of this map lies within a subsidence area
Vertical control based on latest available adjustment
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the
National or State reservations shown on this map
