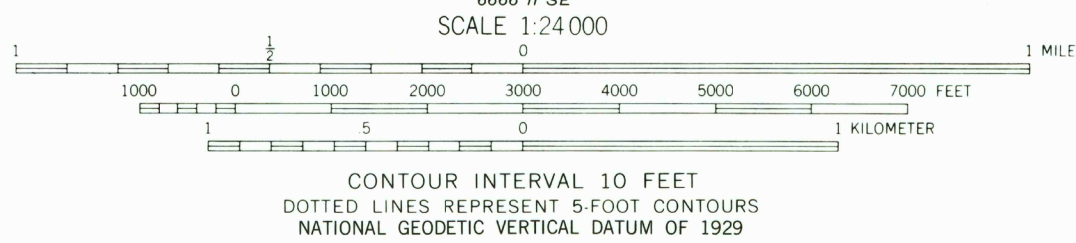

Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown

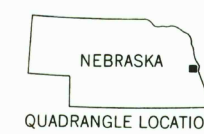
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
