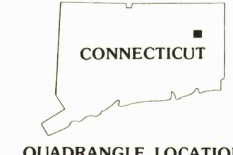
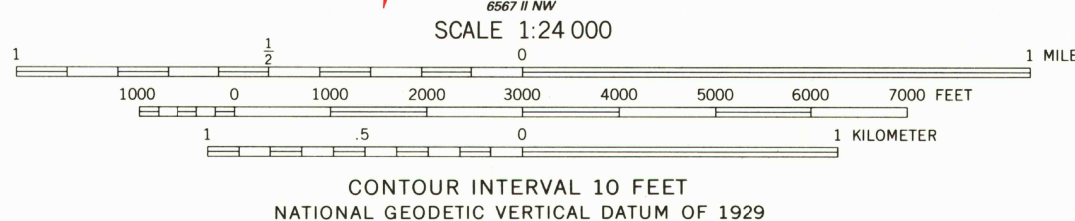
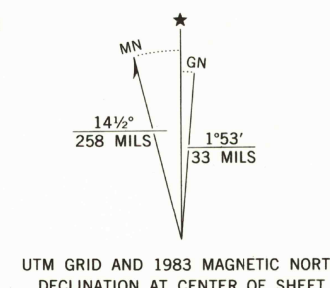

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
