



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Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods Aerial photographs taken 1959. Field check 1960
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Nevada coordinate system, central and east zones
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 8 meters north and 77 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
