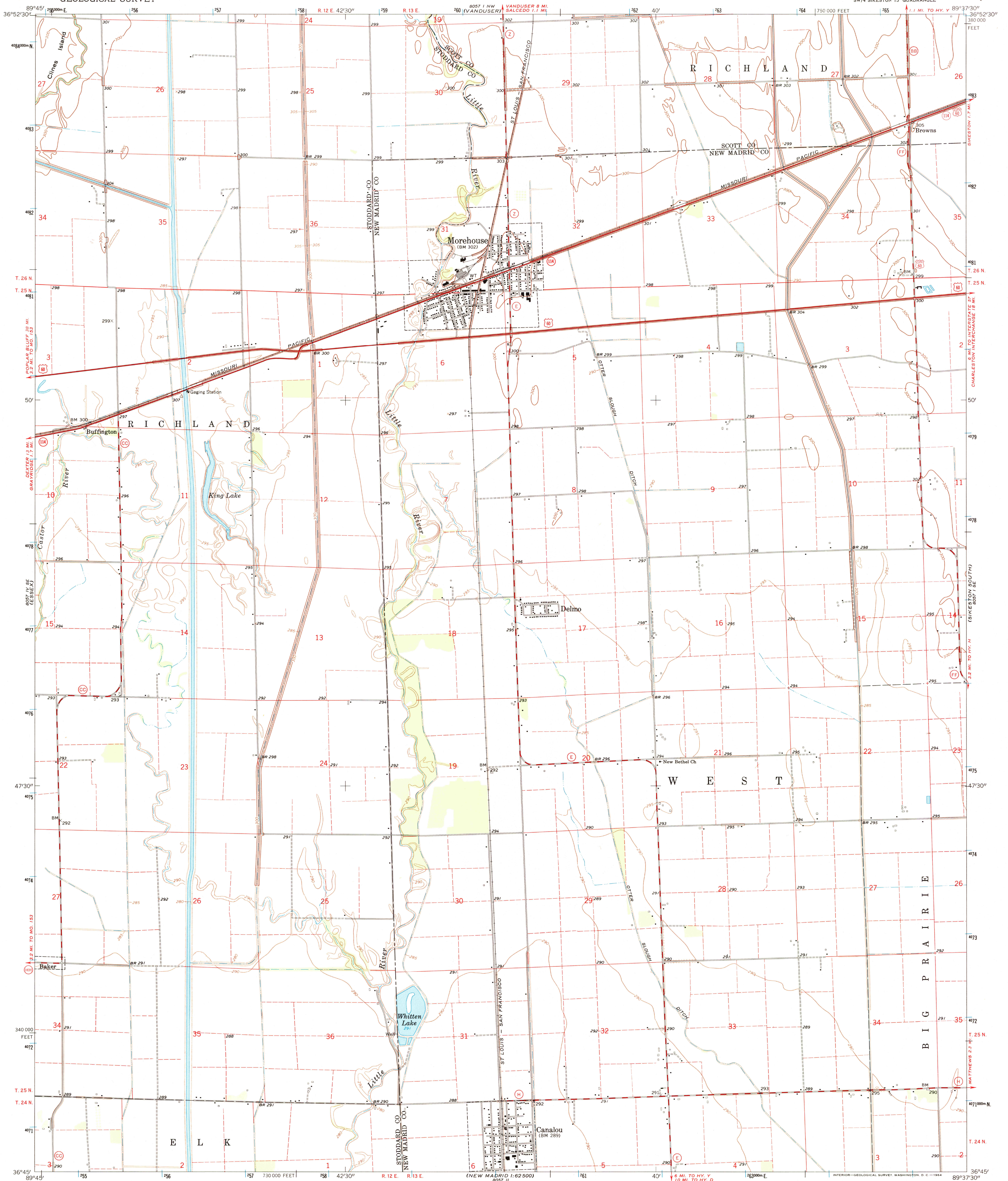

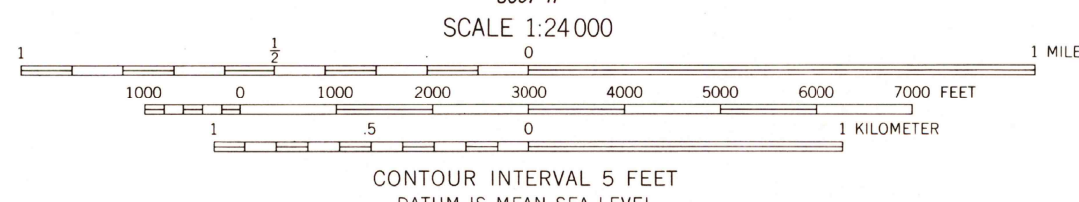
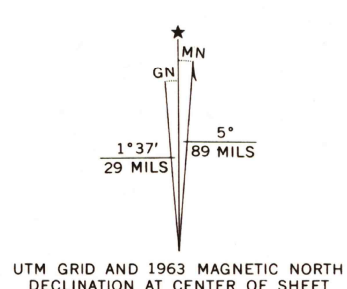

Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1962. Topography by planetable surveys 1962-63

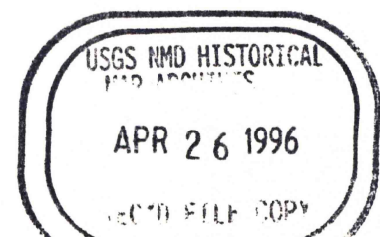
