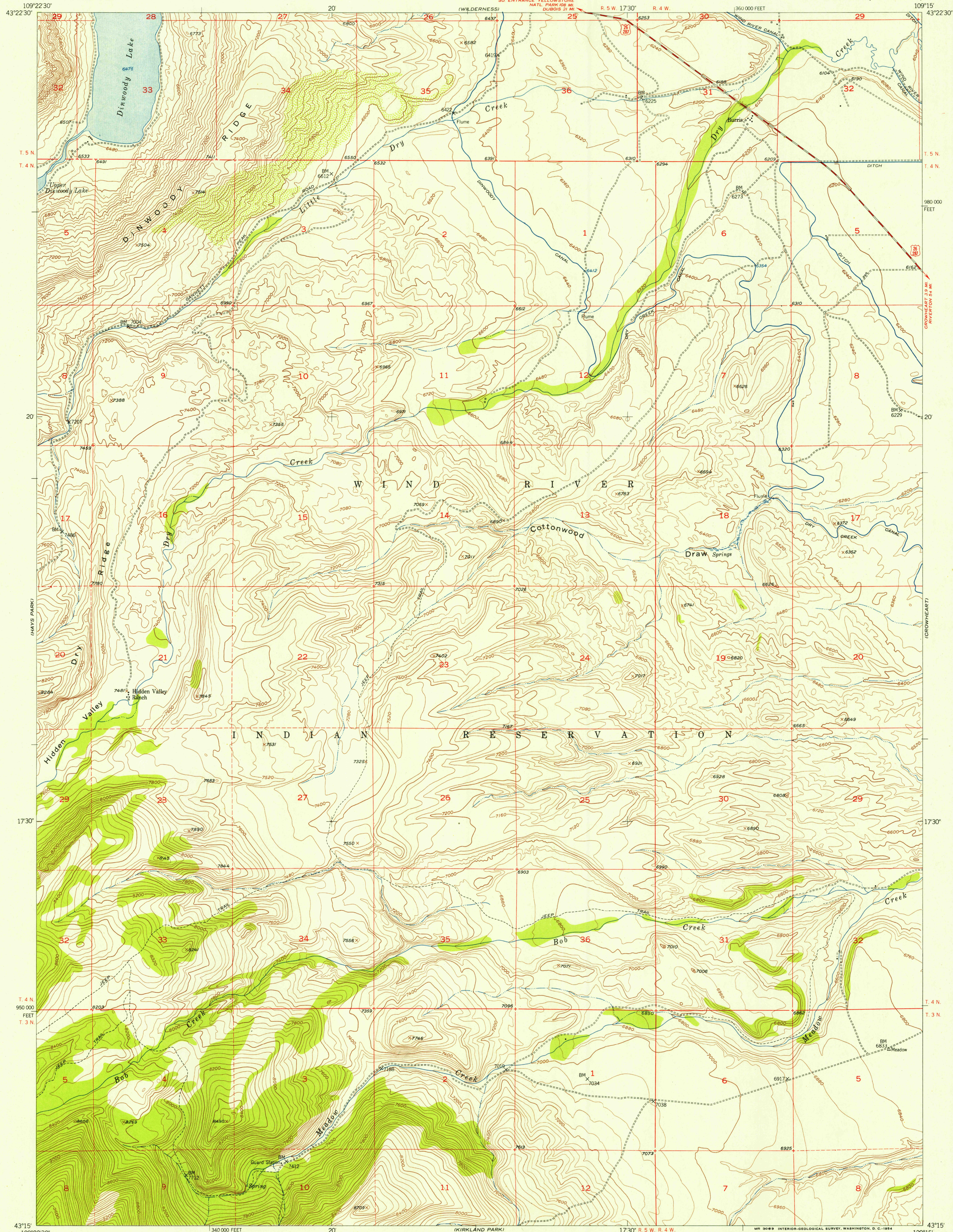




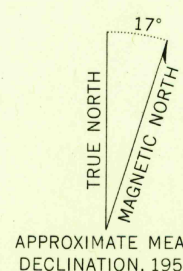

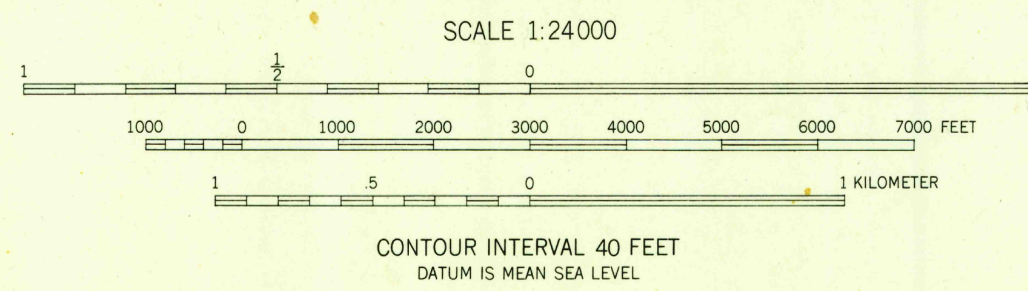

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations



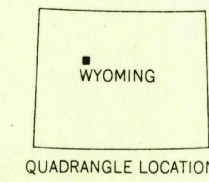
APPROXIMATE MEAN
