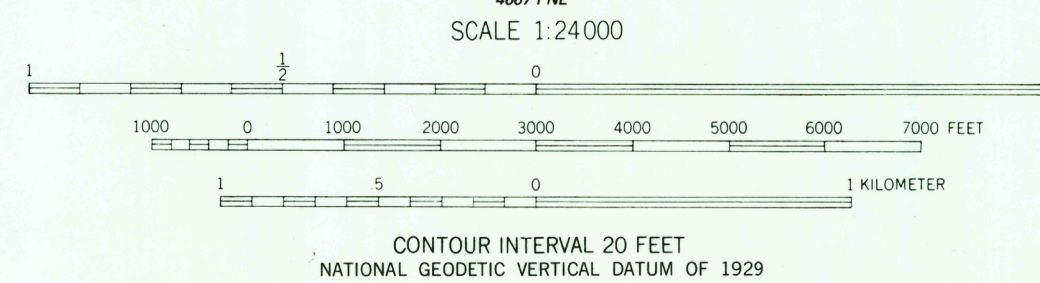
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone

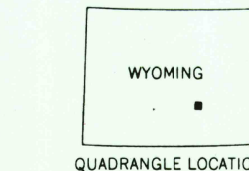
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
