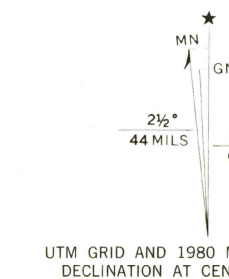
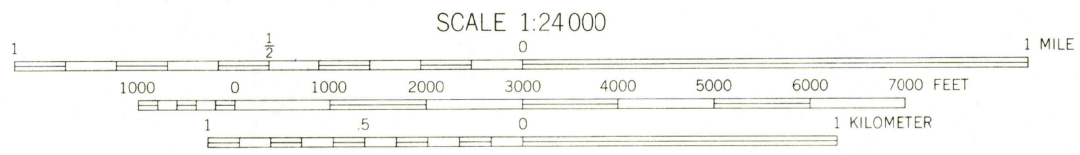

move the projection lines 23 meters south and
17 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
No distinction is made between barns, dwellings
commercial and industrial buildings
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
