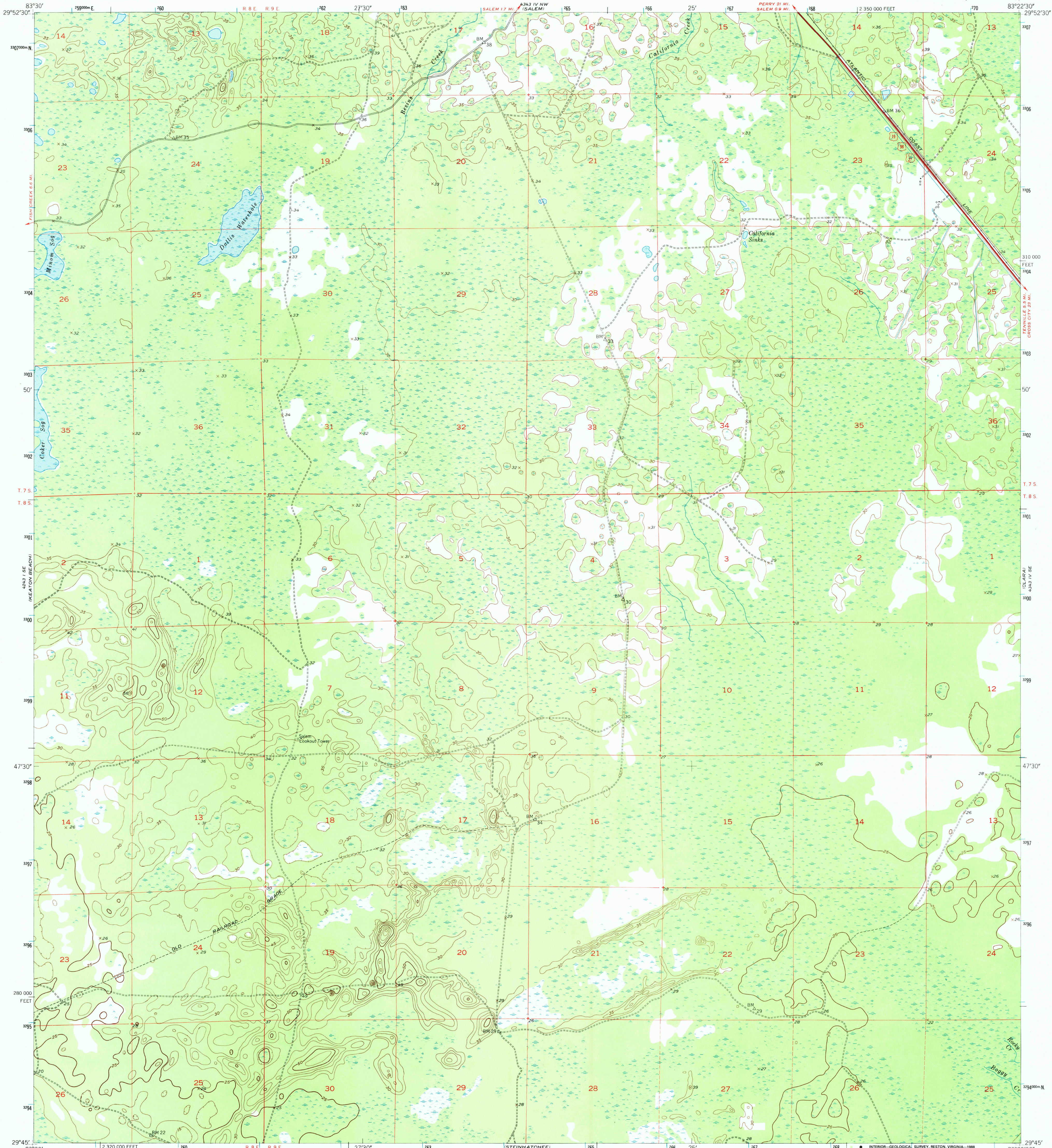

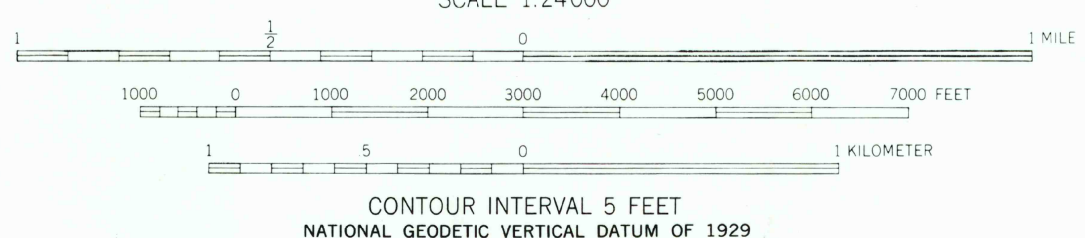
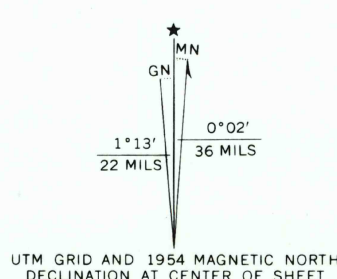

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 22 meters south and 12 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

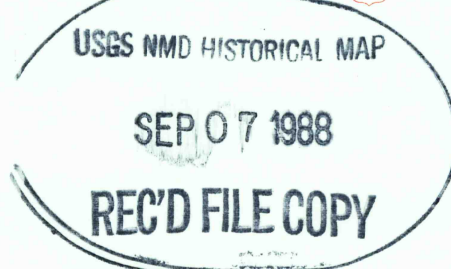


CONTOUR INTERVAL 5 FEET
